- I. Late pick-up and students returned from the bus
 - A. For any student whose parent/quardian is not present at the end of the class period, a teacher will escort the student to after school programming.
 - 1. The wait period is up to the discretion of the teacher; their contracted hours may limit the wait time to no more than five minutes.
 - B. For any student whose parent/quardian is not present at the time the bus arrives at the designated stop, the bus may continue and return to the school after the route is complete.
 - 1. The wait period is up to the discretion of the driver; their route and students on the bus may impact wait time at each stop.
- II. After school programming use
 - A. Kids World is the after school program used at all programming sites in the event a parent or guardian is not present at pick up time or bus stop. Kids World staff have all current preschool rosters and will check in the student to their care. Efforts will be made to reach parents/guardians.
 - 1. If no parent or emergency contact is reachable, Kids World staff will determine appropriate wait time to involve law enforcement depending on the time the student is brought into their care and history with student/family if repeat attender.
 - 2. Kids World reserves the right to charge a fee for the time the student is in their care.
 - 3. Unpaid fees or repeat late pick-ups are subject to being removed from the preschool program.
