Position Title: Assistant Professor of Human Services and Sociology

Position Location: Wingate Main Campus

Wingate University's Department of Sociology seeks to hire a new colleague in **Human Services and Sociology** for Fall 2023. The position is full-time and tenure track.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teach 4 face-to-face courses in human services per semester, including clinical skills-based courses. The incoming faculty member should be prepared to teach Introduction to Human Services, Interviewing and Helping Skills, Group & Community Work, and Human Services Practicum. The ability to contribute to the other department majors (sociology and criminal justice) will be viewed favorably.
- Academic advising for students and regularly scheduled office hours to promote student success
- Service to department, college, and campus community
- Scholarly and professional engagement
- Alignment with University mission, vision, and strategic roadmap
- Regular, predictable attendance on campus
- Other job duties/responsibilities may be assigned

Qualifications and Experience:

Required:

- Master's degree in Human Services, Social Work, or Counseling from a CSHSE, CSWE or CACREP accredited program plus two years college teaching experience or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Experience and credentials to teach undergraduate Human Services courses
- Commitment to teaching excellence and student mentorship
- Demonstrated scholarly and professional engagement

Preferred: PhD in Human Services from a CSHSE accredited program or PHD in Sociology with clinical or practical experience or PhD/DSW from a CSWE accredited program plus two years college teaching experience or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
