UPLAND HIGH SCHOOL DANCE AGREEMENT 2022-2023

The school administration has established certain policies to make sure your dance experience is a good one by providing dance guidelines. In order to purchase dance tickets, students and guests are expected to follow and abide by the school rules outlined in the Student Conduct Handbook, Education Code as well as in this dance agreement. Before you get actual tickets, you may not have any outstanding Saturday Schools, Suspensions for the quarter the dance/activity is being held, or be on the No-Go. If you get a disciplinary consequence before the dance/activity/event, your tickets will be revoked and you are subject to receive a refund. Any violation of school rules or this dance agreement may result in disciplinary action. As long as you remain in good standing, this agreement will remain in effect for the entire school year.

- A photo ID is required for admission.
- Tickets are not refundable.
- Students and guests will not be readmitted to the dance venue after leaving the dance.
- Students and guests will be checked/searched prior to entering the dance and may be subject to a Breathalyzer test. If deemed necessary by the UHS administration, vehicles may be searched. If found to be under the influence or in possession of alcohol and/or drugs, to include tobacco students will be referred to their parents and/or local police. All school and district discipline policies will be enforced.
- There is no smoking and/or vaping.
- All students and guests must arrive within 60 minutes of the published *start time* of the event, or will be denied entry. (For example, if the published start time is 7pm, arrivals after 8pm will be denied entry.) No one will be allowed to leave the event more than 60 minutes before the published *end time* of the event. (For example, if the published end time is 11pm, no one may leave before 10pm.) Exceptions to this rule must be cleared in advance with a UHS Administrator.
- Students and guests who wear inappropriate outfits will not be allowed into the dance. School administration reserves the right to make decisions on student dress based on appropriateness and good taste. When in doubt, ask first.
- Dance movements must fall within the standards of good taste and decency. Students must be upright when dancing. Examples of inappropriate dancing are, but not limited to:
 - Bending over with hands on the floor
 - Being on the floor
 - Sexually suggestive
 - Straddling
 - Lifting or throwing others into the air and/or “crowd surfing”
 - Slamming or “moshing”
- There is no fighting or disorderly conduct, including throwing food and/or water and other liquids.
- Student conduct which violates school or district rules, or state law, may result in the student being denied the privilege of further participation in extracurricular activities and could result in further disciplinary actions.

These expectations are mandatory and any individuals or couples failing to comply may be removed from the dance. Students and Guests will not receive a refund for removal from the dance or if denied entry due to violation of expectations. Parents/Guardian will be required to pick up students from the dance venue.
