 - Coach schools on implementing MTSS



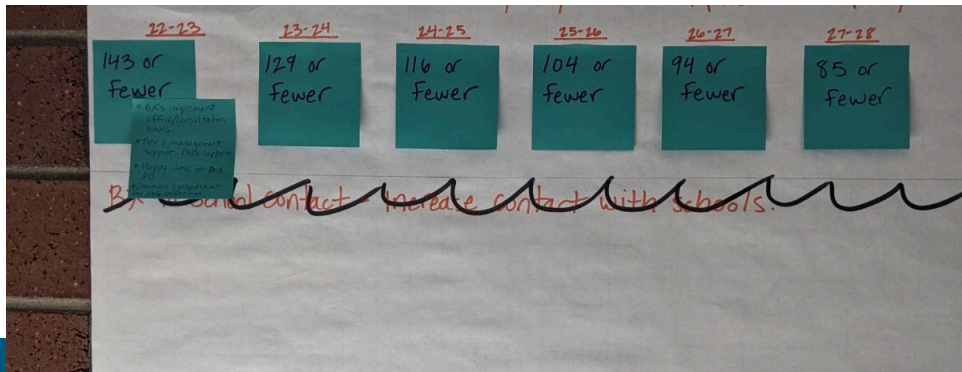
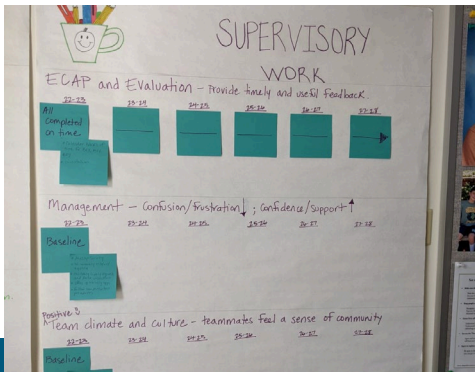
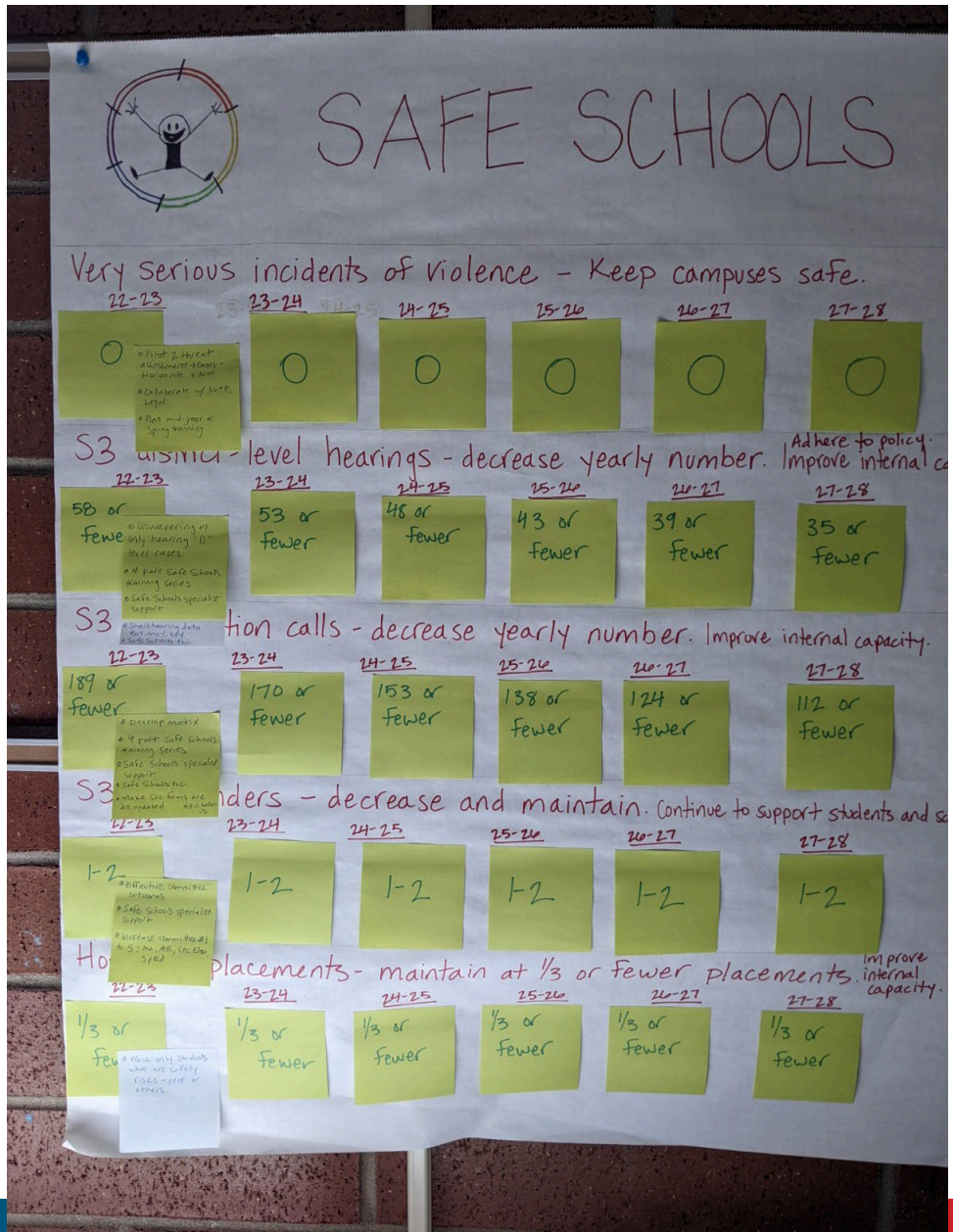
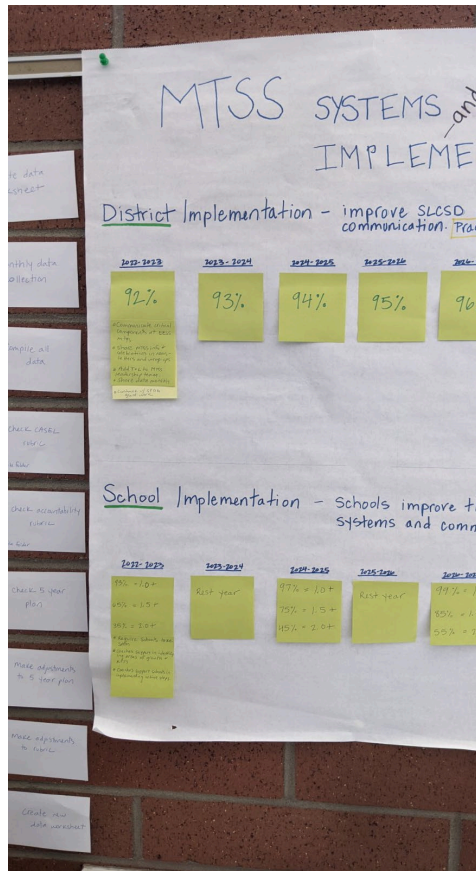
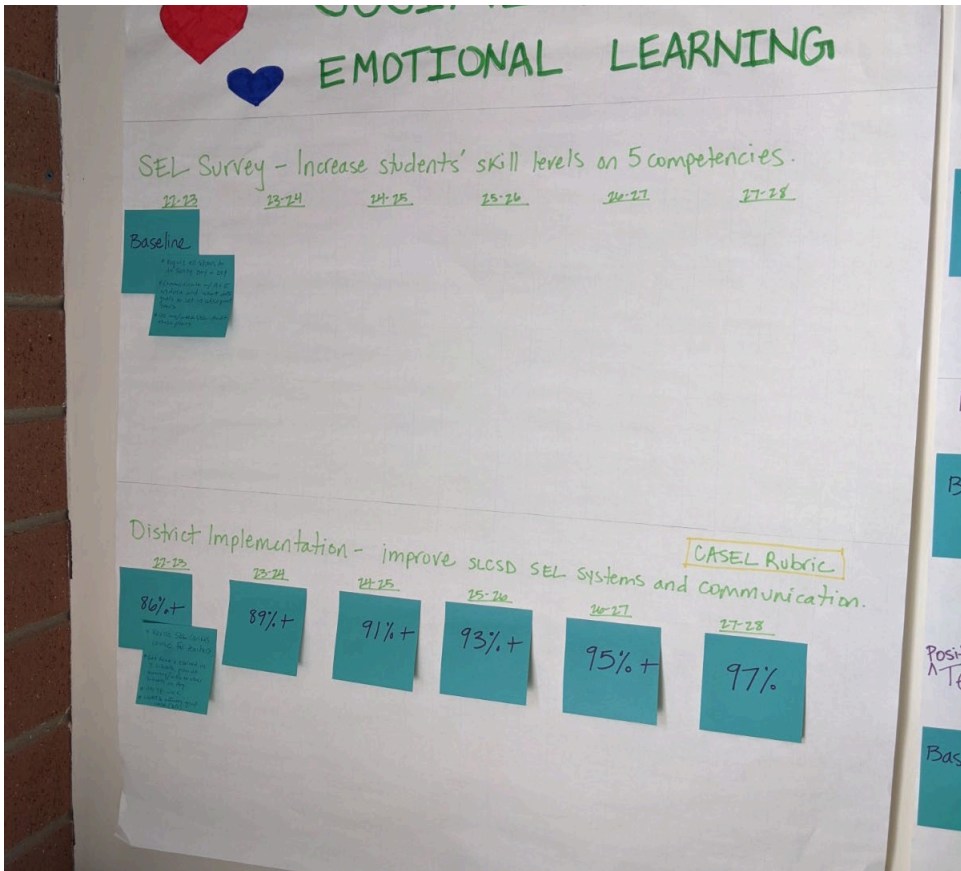
SYSTEMS

HB 58 POSITIVE BEHAVIOR PLANS



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WHAT IS HB 58?

WHAT YOU REALLY NEED TO KNOW...

HB 58 states, “Each school must develop a Positive Behavior Plan to address the causes of student use of tobacco, alcohol, electronic cigarette products, and other controlled substances through promoting positive behaviors.”

- This has been embedded into our [School Board Policy S-3](#).

AND...

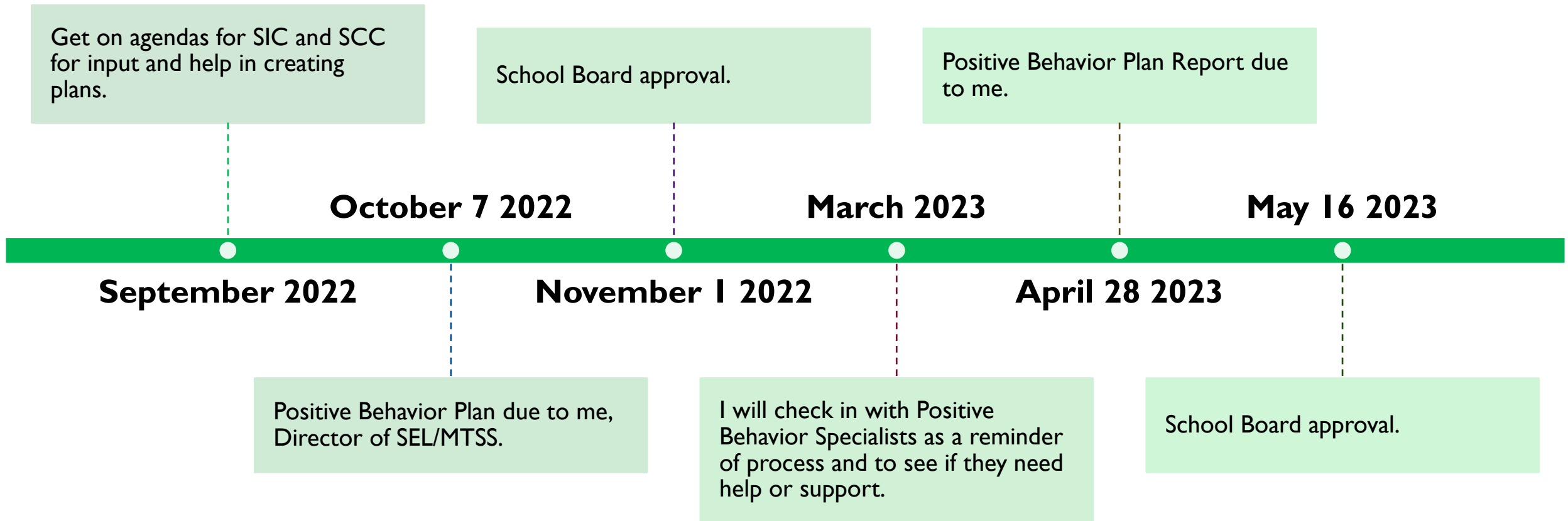
The plan **shall** address issues including peer pressure, mental health, and creating positive relationships.

The plan **may** include programs, clubs, service opportunities, and pro social activities.

WHO IS GOING TO DO THIS?

Per HB 58, the school principal needs to designate a Positive Behavior Specialist to administer the plan.

This person can be the principal, the assistant principal, a counselor, or a teacher-leader. Per your request, we have asked administrators to delegate this year.

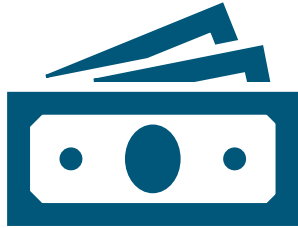
Do you understand the connection between the stated program and the prevention of substance abuse?

Plans will reflect age of students, e.g. secondary plans are more explicit and direct than elementary plans.



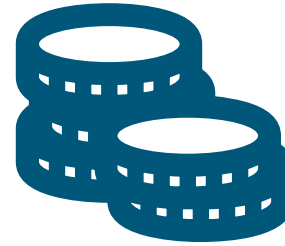
