Parent Training Workshop Schedule 2022-23

Welcome to Half Hollow Hills

Thursday, October 6, 2022

This training will provide an overview of special education programs and services offered within the district. Programs K-12 will be covered as well as explanations of related service models. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions about programs and services during a question and answer period.

Skill Building on the Road to Independence

Wednesday, October 12, 2022

Preparing your child to be an independent individual goes beyond just teaching skills. These skills must be built-up by working on knowledge, confidence, building on to longer more complex skills and executing them. This training will identify areas where independent skills such as safety training, daily living and emotional regulation, can be built as well as strategies to develop them.

Goal Development for ABA Services

Friday, October 21, 2022

In ABA, it is important to create objective goals for students. This helps parents and providers to evaluate progress and to monitor whether the student is truly moving forward in various skill areas, academically and behaviorally. This training will focus on selecting and objectively defining goals appropriate for parents to work on with their children

Functional Behavior Assessment

Wednesday, November 9, 2022

This two-part training will take participants through the process of Functional Assessment and Behavior Plan development step-by-step. During Part I, participants will learn what Functional Behavior Assessment is as well as activities used during this process to identify the functions of a behavior as well as influencing factors.

Self-Care as a Parent or Caregiver

Tuesday November 29, 2022

Caring for another person, no matter who that is, requires mental, emotional, and physical energy from the caregiver. When you don't prioritize caring for yourself, you may experience any number of negative consequences. This training brings attention to the importance of self-care and will provide caregivers with suggestions for how to make self-care a more regular part of their lives.

Discrete Trials

Wednesday, December 7, 2022

Discrete Trial Teaching (DTT) is a teaching strategy that falls under the umbrella of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA). Skills are broken down into smaller components and mastered through repetition. Participants in this training will learn basic concepts of discrete trial teaching and be provided with specific examples.

Winter Fun

Wednesday, December 21, 2022

This training provides families with tips for winter activities including traveling, outdoor activities and staying home. These activities provide opportunities for skill building and practice in naturalistic settings. The importance of planning and structure are highlighted in order to help individuals with autism handle changes in routines and new experiences.

Peer Modeling

Friday, January 6, 2023

Individuals with autism often struggle with aspects of social interactions such as using peers as models in social and learning situations and identifying peers as valuable in helping to solve problems. This training will offer methods for setting up opportunities for peer modeling and creating situations for peer reliance.

Behavior Intervention Plans

Monday, January 30, 2023

The second of this two-part training, will extend the information learned during the training on Functional Behavior Assessment to learn how to develop appropriate interventions. Participants will learn to identify the parts of a behavior plan and select appropriate interventions for behaviors based on function.

Transition to the New School Year

Thursday, February 1, 2023

Students with autism benefit from planning and preparation for the transition to a new school year given difficulties with changes in routine and schedule associated with the diagnosis. Participants will identify factors that make transitions difficult for students with autism. Participants will discuss preparations for the new school year and will match transition supports to the needs of their child. Specific information regarding the transition to middle school and high school will also be shared.

Safety Training

Wednesday, February 15, 2023

Planning and practice are important components to safe and successful outings in the community. This training will assist parents in identifying safety skills that need to be taught as well as how to plan and navigate various community trips.
