

2106.1 AR Parental Objections

A parent who objects to a textbook or other educational materials used by the School District may present a written complaint to the Superintendent identifying the textbook or other educational

materials and the basis of the parent's objection. The Superintendent will refer the written complaint to the School District's Executive Director of Elementary Education or Executive Director of Secondary Education. The Executive Director to whom the complaint is referred will review the complaint and, if necessary, will meet with the parent to develop an understanding of the parent's complaint. The Executive Director will then prepare a written response for the Superintendent's consideration. The written response will include, but not necessarily be limited to, an analysis of the manner in which the textbook or other education materials in question do or do not meet the standards set forth in the District's policies and administrative regulations.

The Superintendent will review the written response and issue a final decision affirming, modifying or reversing the written response. The Superintendent will share the written complaint, the written response and the final decision with the Board of Education.

A textbook or other educational materials subject to such complaint will remain in use pending the Superintendent's final decision.
