- Demonstrates clear, concise written and verbal skills
- Structures information in a meaningful sequence
- Tailors the message for the intended audience
- Provides and accepts feedback



Creativity and Innovation

- Identifies novel approaches to address situations
- Applies or modifies an idea in a new way to generate solutions
- Actively seeks opportunities to try out new ideas
 - Uses resources creatively
 - Originates alternatives to conventional thinking



Character

- Accepts responsibility for choices and follows through on commitments
- Perseveres and adapts despite difficulty
 - Takes initiative
 - Models trustworthiness and dependability
- Expresses empathy to others



Critical Thinking and Problem Solving

- Observes situations in order to define problems
- Asks questions, makes predictions, gathers data, and analyzes information
- Evaluates various solutions and uses evidence to build a viable case
- Uses a range of tools, including technology, to solve a problem



Collaboration

- Engages in collective decision making
- Encourages suggestions and respects ideas from all team members
 - Openly shares information
- Demonstrates a sense of shared responsibility



Citizenship

- Contributes to the enhancement of community life
 - Respects rights of others
- Demonstrates an understanding of financial literacy
- Demonstrates an understanding of civic duty
 - Exhibits technology literacy
 - Displays global awareness
