Did you know?

- BSM students and their families come from more than 58 different cities in the metro area.
- BSM has more than 30 extracurricular athletics and activities programs specifically for BSM Junior High students (with potential opportunities to join high school level teams or clubs).
- Over the last five years, 48% of our BSM Senior High valedictorians began their Red Knight careers in the BSM Junior High.
- BSM offers retreat programs and service learning opportunities for both 7th and 8th grade students.
- The BSM Junior High has a number of support services students and families can take advantage of including, academic/learning specialists, small group support, and 1:1 counselor meetings.
- Students benefit from smaller class sizes (average of 18) while still sharing in the energy and spirit of a larger school environment.
- The BSM Junior High uses WEB (Where Everybody Belongs) to facilitate peer-to-peer mentoring between 7th and 8th grade students.
- There are 50 BSM Junior High students currently enrolled in upper level classes in the BSM Senior High.
- The BSM Junior High employs a full-time counselor who specializes in the middle school environment. The counselor meets with each 7th and new 8th grade student to ensure a smooth transition into BSM and to provide support and guidance throughout their Junior High experience. BSM faculty and staff members also regularly take part in professional development to strengthen their understanding of adolescent mental health.
