# INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

To earn the full IB Diploma, a student must earn a minimum of 24 points in six subjects, complete the Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) requirements, Theory of Knowledge (TOK) class, and write an original 4,000-word Extended Essay in a subject of their choice. Exams are graded on a scale of 1 to 7.

We limit students to three HL courses unless a strict approval process is met.

## **ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)**

Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take the exams for those courses. Exams are graded on a scale of 1 to 5.

Students in the class of 2024 were permitted to take one AP course in Grade 9, one in Grade 10, three in Grade 11, and four in Grade 12. Registration requests beyond these limits can be approved by the Administrative Team through a highly selective process.
