

# Photo Submission Tips

## USING A SMARTPHONE

Today's iPhones and Android phones all take images that are high-enough resolution. But, when you email them, you must do so at *the original size*.

On an iPhone, a dialogue pops up giving you an option to reduce the message size. "Actual Size" should always be chosen.

## MAIL APP ON A MAC

On a Macintosh computer, using Apple Mail, there is an option to select "Actual Size."

## GMAIL ON A WEB BROWSER

Using Gmail on a web browser, there is no option for specifying size. But if you choose "Attach files," it will send it actual size.

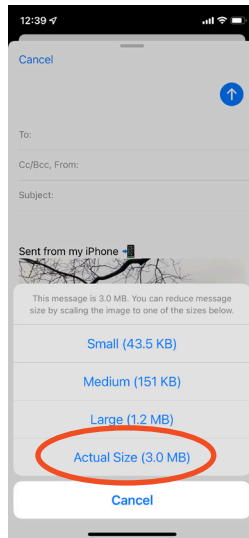
If you choose the camera icon in the "Send" options, the image will automatically be reduced to about half the original size, which is not good!

## DIGITAL CAMERAS

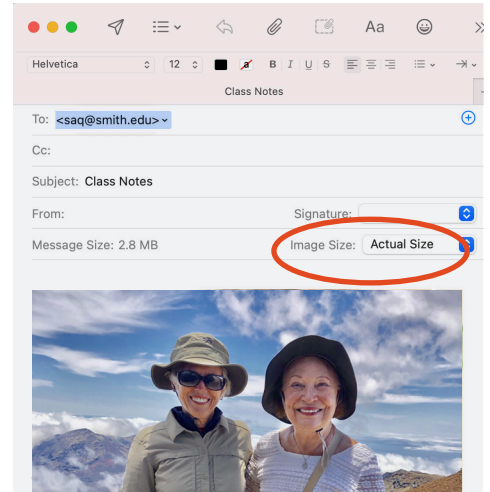
Point-and-shoot cameras and other digital cameras all have different options for shooting resolutions. You should always choose the highest-quality setting.

## IDEAL IMAGE SIZE

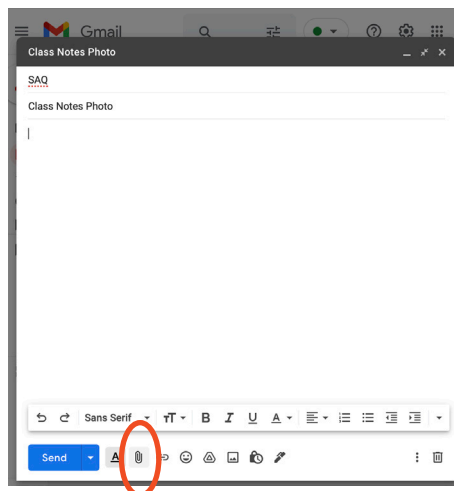
Overall, the ideal image size should be a minimum of 3MB.
