- Land Trust- Emphasis will be placed on Math. We will also pay salary for Computer Manager.
- Currently had 345 students enrolled. This is an increase from last year.
- Title I- we will be having some parent meetings/ bulk of budget is being used to retain a teacher so that each grade level has two with the exception of 7th and 8th who have 3 together.
- Budgets look good due to the savings Mrs. Battle was able to do during the pandemic
- Need paraprofessionals for PE, Computer Lab, and Essential Elements classes. For this year, we can offer full time with the option of benefits for PE and Comp. Lab
- School Improvement Plan is in progress and will be sent out when approved, foci- literacy for ELLs- 30% will meet goals, math-increase the number of students reaching proficiency by 6%, TSI- waiting on data
- Crossing Guards- Student Government will be this year's guards
- School Safety- District has been having "table talk" discussions with police, fire dept, etc. Trainings are currently being done at the district level and will be done at the schools. Front door is fixed.
