RPS preschool prepares children for future school readiness and lifelong learning success. Our teachers believe that children learn through play by stimulating their imaginations, offering opportunities to explore, and fostering strong relationships between the teacher, child, and family.

During structured activities, children increase their skills in communication, math and problem-solving. Teachers expand children's language skills by asking open-ended questions, exposing children to new and unique vocabulary, and creating language rich environments. Teachers also build students' number sense and early mathematical conceptual understanding.

Children engage in a wide range of hands-on activities that challenge them to observe closely, ask questions, test ideas, solve problems and improve their physical abilities. Children develop healthy social and emotional skills, such as managing their feelings, learning to express themselves appropriately, and developing positive relationships with their peers. Social emotional learning is an early priority since it forms the foundation for all academic learning and future school readiness.

We recognize that parents and caregivers are children's first and best teachers. Learning happens when children are interacting with their families, teachers, friends and environment. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to continue those conversations with their children at home and/or participate in the classrooms as volunteers.
