## Transportation

Safety is our primary concern when transporting children. A monitor is placed on each bus to ensure the safety of the children. Children must sit in a booster seat, which provides additional safety features for young children. Parents must sign the Transportation Agreement Form acknowledging that they agree to comply with the guidelines established by RPS Preschool.

## Bus Stop Supervision

Preschool children may not, under any circumstances, wait for the school bus at the bus stop without the presence of a parent/ guardian or authorized individual.

Children will only be released to parents/guardians and authorized persons designated on the emergency contact form (NO EXCEPTIONS). Individuals listed must have a photo I.D. to pick up the child and be at least 16 years of age or older (NO EXCEPTIONS).

Switching bus stops is not permitted.



Bus drivers cannot always guarantee an exact arrival time. The parent/guardian or authorized individual responsible for placing the child(ren) on/off the bus must allow for a 20 minute window.

Failure to meet the school bus in the afternoon may result in a follow up from the school.

Children who are not met at the school bus stop will be returned to their school of attendance.

Children must be met by a parent/guardian or authorized individual within 30 minutes of the bus' return to the school of attendance.

Failure to meet the bus within 60 minutes of the bus' return may result in a phone call to Child Protective Services (CPS) if emergency contacts cannot be reached.

Children will not be released to anyone appearing intoxicated or in medical distress.
