Guidelines for the PTO After School Programs

We ask that you please keep in mind the following guidelines:

- All sessions are held from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Children will be dismissed from their homeroom upon the announcement and should walk to the classroom where the club is being held. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to remind his/her child on the day they are scheduled to attend a program. Children will not be walked to their after school program by a teacher.
- A <u>written note must be sent in ADVANCE</u> to your child's homeroom teacher if they are not able to attend class. If a note is not received, your child will be directed to go to the after school program. They will not be sent home on the bus without a note.
- Parents are responsible for transportation. Children must be picked up promptly at 4:00 p.m. Parents must come out of their car to pick up their child(ren). If you are arranging for someone other than yourself to pick up your child, please send a written note to your child's teacher. If a child is picked up late from a program twice, he/she may be dropped from the program. Money will not be refunded.
- Your child will be <u>dismissed from the gym doors on the side of the building (#7 and #8)</u>. When picking up your child, please be sure to park your car in the designated parking spaces. For safety reasons, <u>DO NOT DOUBLE PARK YOUR CAR. PLEASE DRIVE CAREFULLY AND SLOWLY.</u>
- If a child causes a disruption in a program, he/she will be given a warning. A second offense may result in the child being dropped from the program. Money will <u>not</u> be refunded. Refunds will not be given for absences. Refunds will not be given after the course has started.
- In the event of a school closure, holidays, or a teacher is absent, classes will be made up. Parents will be notified of the make-up dates. If a student is absent, no make-up classes will be offered.
- Parents are to wait for their children outside of the school building. Please do not ring the bell to enter into the school prior to the dismissal of the class.
- In the event that the teacher of this course is out sick, please be prepared to have your child dismissed at 2:45 p.m. and sent home. We will make every attempt to reach you by phone. Please keep phone numbers UP-TO-DATE! If we are unable to reach you, for your child's safety, he/she will be held at the school and you will have to pick them up at the office at dismissal time (2:45 p.m.).
- Please note: There may not always be a school nurse on duty during after school hours. Should a medical issue arise, calls will be made to the number you have provided to us. As previously stated, it is imperative to keep your emergency contact numbers up-to-date!!
