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WHAT IS GT?

“Gifted and talented student” means a child or youth who performs at or **shows the potential** for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who:

- (1) exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area;
- (2) possesses an unusual capacity for leadership; or
- (3) excels in a specific academic field.

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GT PROGRAM DESIGN

GT students will:

- Be served within the school day
- Work together as a group, work with other students and work independently
- Engage in flexible grouping and independent investigations which will be provided throughout the program
- Have the opportunity for acceleration and flexible pacing; allowing students to learn at the pace and level appropriate to their ability and skills.
- Work to develop advanced learning products and/or performances (TPSP)





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TM INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL

Program Design:

- Combination of pull-out and inclusion
 - Students will meet with the GT coordinator/STEAM teacher to launch new learning
 - Students will work in the classroom with teacher during WIN Time on GT products with support from GT STEAM teacher
- Classroom instruction will be differentiated in the TIER I learning environment to meet the needs of GT students
- GT Coordinator will collaborate with classroom teachers



G/T students develop innovative products and sophisticated projects that reflect originality and creativity and are targeted to an audience outside the classroom.

A gifted/talented student is one who performs at or shows the potential for performing at a remarkably high level of accomplishment when compared to others of the same age, experience, or environment and who

- exhibits high performance capability in an intellectual, creative, or artistic area;
- possesses an unusual capacity for leadership; or
- excels in a specific academic field. (Texas Education Code [§29.121](#))
