General Announcements

Our Main Office staff have been working really hard to get in touch with all families that have not yet submitted all of their scholars enrollment documents. Please note students will not be allowed into the building without an up-to-date physical/immunization record. Documents can be emailed to gplesemainoffice@girlsprep.org.

Please complete the <u>Family Income Inquiry Form</u> which is our school lunch form.

For families in need of updating important student demographic information this can be done by emailing the Main Office at <u>GPLESEmainoffice@girlsprep.org</u>.

Types of information to update include address change, pick-up adults, any changes in medical status and emergency contacts.

Requests for school verification letters can be emailed to GPLESEmainoffice@girlsprep.org. Please note the turnaround time is 48 hours. If your family has moved since enrolling into the school, you can share updated proof

of address by emailing your lease, photo ID, HRA letter, or utility bill.

This year we will be welcoming families into our school building for various events such as unity meetings, whole school sing-alongs, and other family events. **To** attend in-person (in-building) events families must show proof of vaccination (in accordance with DOE regulations) to attend.

<u>Arrival & Dismissal Information:</u>

- Arrival doors open at **7:40am** and close at **8:00am** sharp.
- After 8:00am, your scholar will be considered late (except PreK). Late scholars (and PreK students arriving after 8am) will need to be brought up by their guardians to the Main Office in room 316 to be accounted for in our building for safety purposes.
- **Dismissal during Welcome Week is at 12:30pm until 12:50pm**. Anything after 12:50pm will be considered a late pick-up and families will have to come to the main office in room 316 to pick-up their child.
- **Dismissal during the regular school year will be from 3:10-3:30**. Anything after 3:30pm will be considered a late pick-up and families will have to come to the main office in room 316 to pick-up their child.

School Supply List

Below you will find a suggested supply list to send with your scholar during welcome week:

- Facial Tissue

- Baby wipes (scent free)
- Clorox Wipes
- Disposable Masks
- 1 Box of Gallon size ziploc bags
- Pencils

- Pencil sharpeners

All scholars should come to school with their labeled refillable water bottle.

It is imperative that each scholar has their own of the following items in a labeled ziploc bag in the event of a bathroom emergency:

- Change of clothes (white shirt & black/navy blue leggings)
- Panties/Underwear
- Tights/Socks/Leggings
- Change of footwear











Uniform Requirement

Uniforms unite us as a community, increase academic focus and decrease clothing competition. All students are required to arrive at school and leave school in their school uniform, including field trips, half-days, the day before a major holiday, and the last day of school (unless otherwise noted by school leadership). Students are not allowed to change out of uniform at the end of the school day. If a student does not arrive to school in proper uniform, she or he will be provided with a full uniform or missing uniform piece by the school, if available, or have a family member bring a uniform to school for him or her to change into.

Note: We do not dress up for Halloween or any other holiday. Opportunities for dressing up or down are announced by the school leadership team. Scholars and staff enjoy school spirit days to build community, provide an opportunity for individual expression and have fun!
