RHS COURSES

- Our experienced and highly educated teachers bring a depth of knowledge to coursework that provides students with rigor, relevance and personalization.
- Career pathways offer interested students the opportunity to explore their passions through specific coursework aligned to industry pathways.
- Students can choose to engage in numerous athletic and co-curricular activities, including participation in community partner work that serves our city in numerous capacities.
- College in the Schools (CIS) allows students to take college level classes at RHS while earning college credits for free. Last school year, our students earned 1,934 credits through the University of Minnesota, saving families close to \$1,000,000 in college tuition.
- Students may benefit from specialized services/offerings such as: Advanced placement (AP); special education; dual language immersion (DLI) in Spanish; multi-language learning (MLL); and tiered reading and math classes.
