Calvin Rosenbaum, Keith Abraham, Terry Weaver and John Slattery set a new school mile relay record of 3:36.3 in taking a full 1.2 seconds off of last year's mark.



The two mile relay team consisting of Cal Rosenbaum, Vince Beyers, Russel Pratt and Keith Abraham, set a new school record for that event with an 8:52.1 clocking.
