- HB 312 Regards debit and credit usage by political subdivisions.
- HB 87 Addresses money returned to state from community school audits.
- HB 176 Addresses school assessments and curricular teacher evaluations.
- HB 360 Enact Ohio Anti-Bullying and Hazing Act.
- HB 170 Would require the State Board of Education to adopt academic content standards and model curriculum for computer science.
- HB 102 Would replace locally levied school district property taxes with a statewide property tax.
- HB 108 Would require one-half unit of financial literacy in the high school curriculum.

There does not look like there will be additional funding in future budgets for schools.
