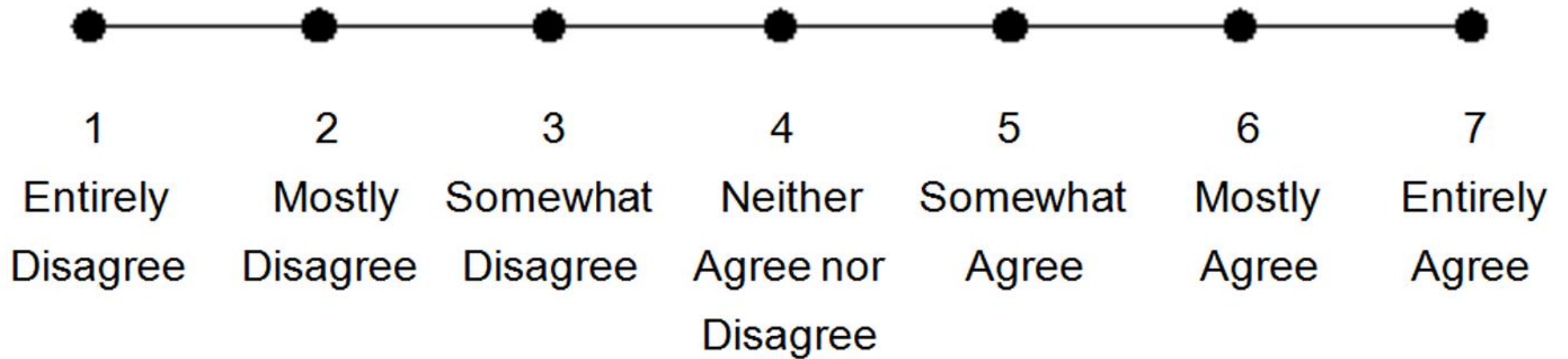

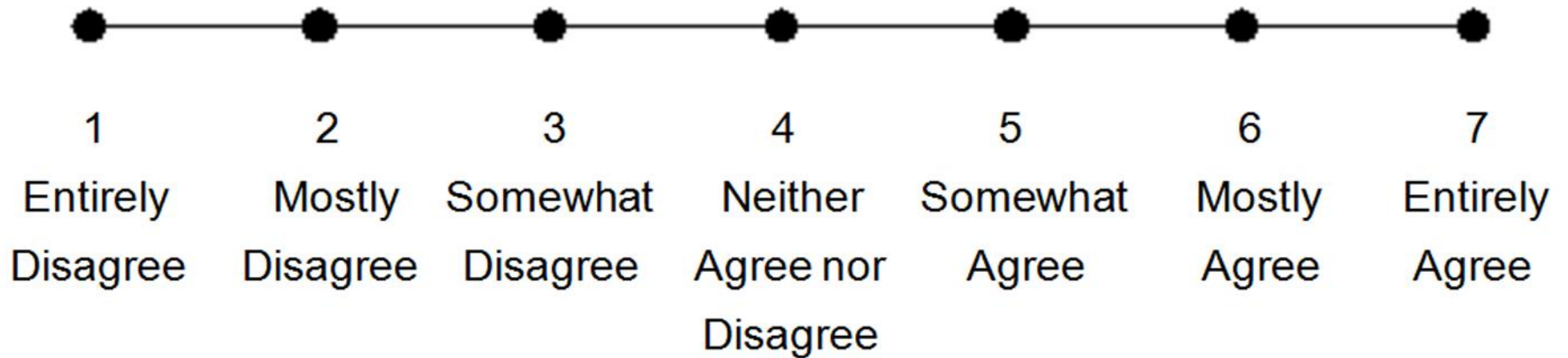

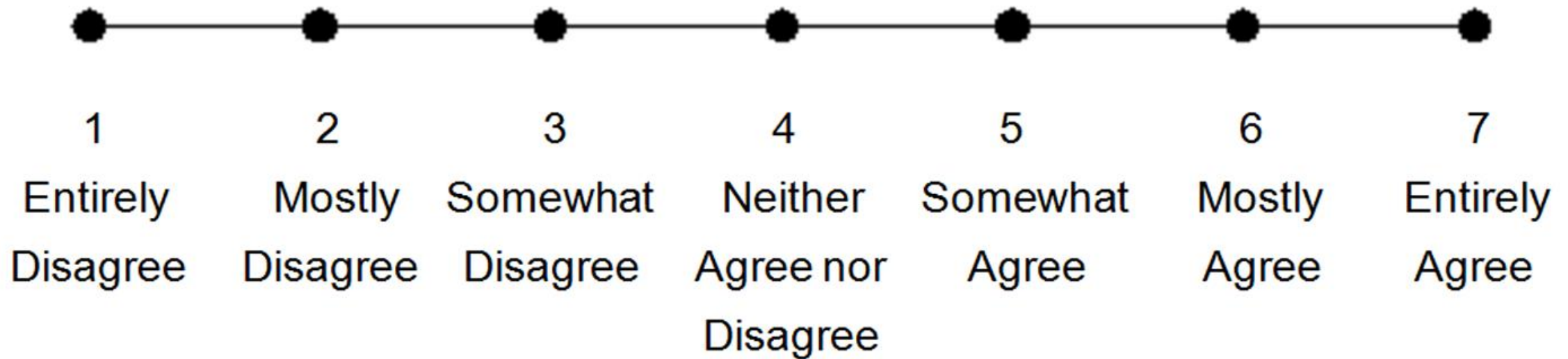
I consistently feel like I belong at RMS.



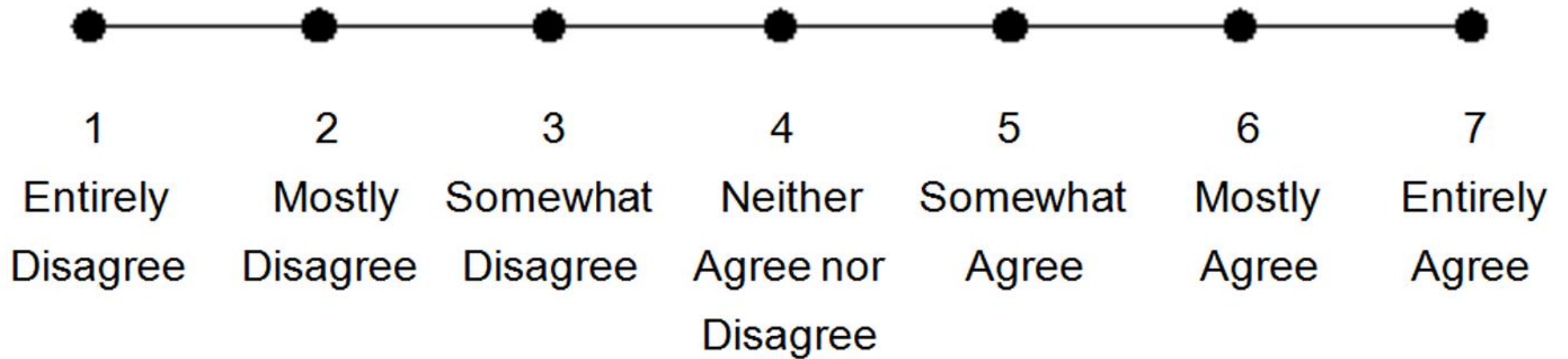
All student's voices are valued at RMS.

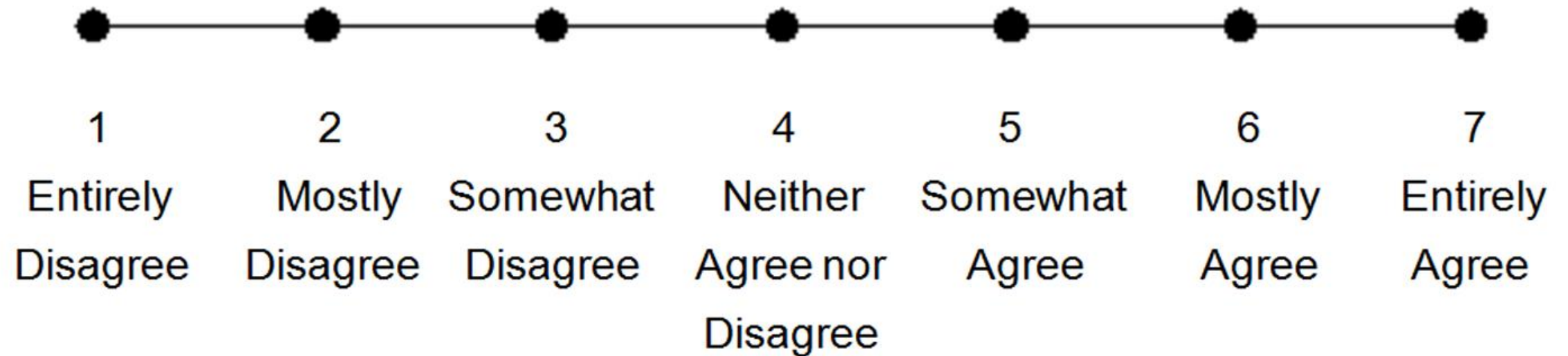


I feel connected to the students at RMS



I have at least 1 staff member I can trust.



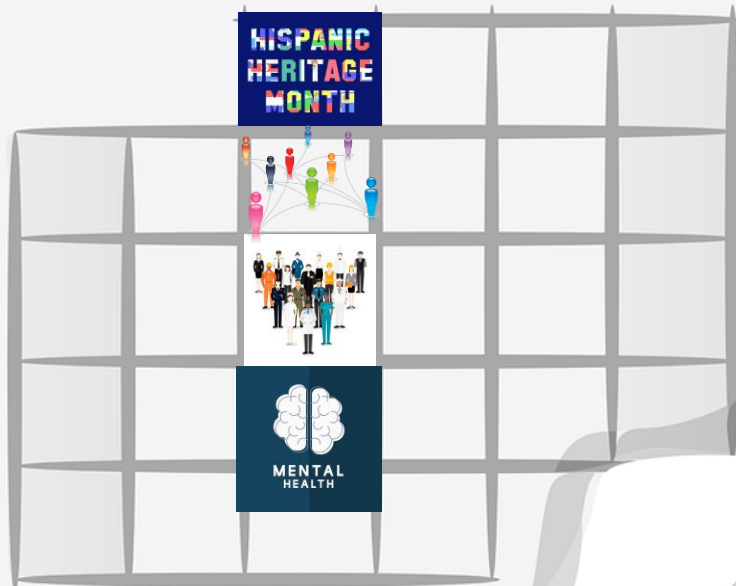


Grizzly Time is a **PLACE** for connection, joy, change, and belonging.

WHAT ARE GRIZZLY TIME REPS?

- From **every** Grizzly Time Class, there will be **one student** who will be *representing their class* in a meeting **every 1st and 3rd Thursday** of the month.
- During this meeting, Grizzly Time Reps will have an opportunity to address their concerns and suggest any ideas for how to make RMS better!
- This is a great time to have your voice be heard!

Take 2 minutes of silent think/write time to fill a post it note (or notecard) ***with your ideas*** about how to make our school better!

REQUIREMENTS

- The representative must have an ASB membership
- The representative must have a 2.5 (C+) GPA or higher at the time of the election, and must maintain a 2.5 (C+) GPA or higher while serving as a Grizzly time representative
- The representative must be available for all meetings, and if not, the secondary rep must be available
- If both representative and secondary are unavailable or have conflicted matters, then information will be sent to the teacher, or a volunteer will take their place



TIME FOR SPEECHES!

- Anyone who is interested in running for your class, has up to one minute to say why your class should elect you!
- Some things you could mention are, why you are interested in running, what past experiences you have, what ideas you have, why your classmates should elect you, or anything else you would like to say.

VOTING

Once everyone who wants to run has been identified and has said what they want to say (within the 1-minute time limit), we get to vote!

The voting process is a simple, nonformal, hand raise vote. (Teachers, you can decide if you want to do it with heads down)
