A big-picture thinking event to hear the community's goals, aspirations, and priorities for the project.

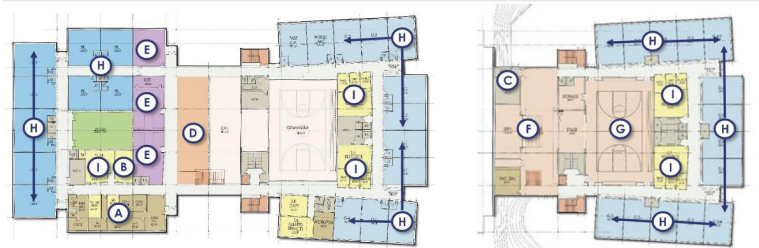

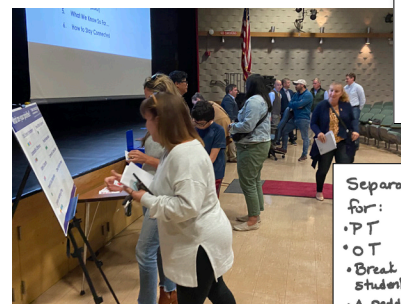
