







FACILITIES NEEDS COMMITTEE (FNC) RECOMMENDATIONS

 FNC recommended the District pursue a November 2022 General Obligation Bond (GO Bond) Measure to fund high priority needs:




Phoenix High School Expansion & Modernization Twelve Bridges High School Completion of Phase 2




MEASURE G - NOVEMBER 8, 2022

- If approved, Measure G would fund the high priority improvements recommended by the FNC
 - \$185 million bond measure
 - District's FMP identified over \$2 billion of capital improvement needs
 - No other funding sources available to complete these projects
 - Projects are essential to the educational program offered to our students




FUNDING FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES IS LIMITED

- □ Statutory School Facility Fees a.k.a. "Developer Fees" (Ed Code 17620)
 - Pays for about $\frac{1}{3}$ of the cost for new facilities
- State Funding School Facility Program (SFP)
 - Pays for about $\frac{1}{3}$ of the cost for new facilities
 - Receipt of funds occurs 5-7 years after the facility project is completed
- Local Funding Parcel Tax, General Obligation Bond
 - Parcel Tax
 - Can be used to augment school district operational costs, including ongoing maintenance costs
 - Requires 2/3 registered voter approval
 - General Obligation Bond
 - Loans issued by school districts and repaid by an ad valorem (according to assessed value) tax on property tax bills
 - Amount of the bonds a district can issue per bond measure is limited by the resulting tax rate, with a maximum tax rate of \$60/\$100,000 of assessed value
 - Requires 55% registered voter approval




WPUSD HAS BEEN GREAT STEWARDS OF TAXPAYER DOLLARS


- Projects funded from Measures A and N were delivered successfully even with very limited budgets
 - Constructed at a fraction of the cost of other schools built during the same timeframe
- Both previous bond measures were focused on only 2 projects each, with bond authorization equal to about 20% of the District's bonding capacity.
