AGAINST COMMUNICABLE DISEASES**

I understand that it is required that each student entering Wakulla County Schools for the first time must show proof of :

- 1. A physical examination**
- 2. Immunization against communicable diseases**

I understand that it is my responsibility to provide the schools with the proof that my child has met these requirements before he/she is officially enrolled in the Wakulla County Schools.

- 1. A tetanus-diphtheria (Td) booster**
- 2. A 2nd dose of measles vaccine (MMR)**
- 3. At least the first of three shots for hepatitis B. (The 2nd and 3rd shots can be completed after school starts.)**
- 4. Varicella (Chicken-Pox)
A student must have this vaccine before entering the 6th grade or proof of having chicken-pox as a child.**

If a student is from a state which does not require the Hepatitis B shots, he/she will have 30 days from date of entry to begin this series.

If, within 30 days of school entry, proof of meeting these requirements has not been provided, my child will be dropped from the school roster and will not be permitted to re-enter until I have the necessary proof required.
