Affordable Connectivity Program

Thanks to a new federal benefit, the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP), lower-income households can get \$30 per month for internet service (\$75 per month for tribal households) and a one-time \$100 discount for devices. One of the goals of the program is to close the homework gap, giving all students the opportunity to work on online assignments at home.

Families who qualify for free and reduced-price school lunch, Medicaid, WIC, SNAP, EBT, SSI, or Federal Public Housing Assistance are eligible.

The city and school district are working together to identify safety concerns created during high-traffic times near Philomath's school buildings. Information gathered in this survey will be presented at the City Council meeting October 24 at 7 pm at the City Hall Council Chambers, 980 Applegate St. Members of the School Board will be in attendance to discuss the findings. The information will then be passed on to a consulting firm made up of traffic engineers and planners that will provide the community with a report of high-risk areas and recommended improvements.
