Registering for Free-School Meals (Pupil Premium)

For families who are on lower income, the Government gives their children's school extra money and it also gives the children free school meals. This is called Pupil Premium money. This money makes a real difference to our school. It helps us pay for a Teaching Assistant in every class every morning of the

week. It also helps us to run catch-up groups for children who need it.

Those children registered for Free School Meal (Pupil Premium) can also claim financial support from the school for trips, uniform, music lessons, and other activities.

Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two receive free school meals but this alone does not make the Government give us Pupil Premium money. For this to be paid, parents have to register on-line using the link below. It is quick, confidential and benefits your child and other children in the school enormously.

Holiday Club



The children all have their Christmas design samples now. Parents can purchase Christmas cards, gift tags, tea towels or mugs as a keepsake or gift for a loved one. Each class had a theme design and then learnt a technique and then applied it to their own interpretation. Last year this activity raised £457.14. If we can raise the same or more this year that would really help towards our next fundraising target to raise money for new musical instruments. £644.70 would fund a class pack of 30 glockenspiels.

IMPORTANT - this year Class Fundraising (our supplier) have moved to an online process. This means that if you would like to order then you can order via their website (full details are attached to the design along with the unique code). You can order as many items as you like, and they are usually delivered to school in plenty of time for Christmas.

FoBIPS can only check the orders once they arrive so parents MUST check the spelling of their child's name at point of ordering and amend where necessary.

*Some children decided to design their cards in landscape format - at this stage, we do not know if you can rotate the design at point of ordering.

Please DO NOT return any forms or payment to school – this process is now online.
