1. Opening prayer led by Bridget Hanson
2. Guest Speaker: Mr. Tony Trudel, DCHS Principal
 - a. Showed floorplan for the updated BFLC, currently under construction. There will be collaboration spaces conducive to group study. It will be open daily until 5pm for students.
 - b. Presented results from the 2021-22 school culture survey. There were 12 categories, indicators of school culture. Had results from 442 students, 60 faculty, and 128 parents. Consistently, high scores were for safety rules and norms, physical surroundings. Consistently, lower scores were for sense of social-emotional security and social media.
 - c. He is a planner, thinking of cycles and continual improvement. Shared the updated DCHS Mission & Vision statements. The Mission is the school's purpose. The Vision is a 3-5 year, temporary statement.
 - d. There will be early release monthly so that teachers can work with coaches for professional development.
