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School Safety

Emergency Alerts, School Delays and cancellations

As the weather continues to change we want to remind all families to be sure that you have downloaded the TSC2Go app and joined the Emergency Alert system that is in use for Tippecanoe School Corporation. We recommend signing up for alerts from Southwestern and McCutcheon, as well as Mintonye, as bus delays at those schools can impact our busing. Sign up instructions can be found on the TSC website. The TSC2Go App is one of the best official, immediate and reliable sources of any delay/cancellation.

Bus Information

At this time the transportation is NOT allowing bus passes (children may not ride home with another student if it is not their assigned bus).

Be sure to sign up for "Here Comes the Bus". Here Comes the Bus® allows parents real-time access to your child's bus location through an online portal. This technology will allow parents to create a secure account and log on through any internet connection and get information such as:

- The scheduled pick-up time (morning) and drop-off time (afternoon) for your specific address;
- Possible delays in anticipated pick-up or drop-off times;
- Knowledge of actual pick-up and drop-off times, after the event has occurred;
- Real-time view of the current location of the bus, including an understanding of the direction and location of the bus;
- Notification when the bus has reached the final destination (the school)

Do you have an afterschool change of transportation plans?

If you have a change in the NORMAL method your child takes to get home from school please communicate that information to the school office **PRIOR to 2pm**. We will not be able to change transportation plans after 2pm so please plan accordingly. You can can email Mrs. West, Mrs. Bowyer or your students teacher or simply write a note to send with your child in the morning stating the change of plans. Thank you for making arrangements in advance of the school day and helping us to limit classroom interruptions!

Volunteers/Chaperones

If you plan to volunteer at school or to attend a field trip, either as a chaperone or a guest, you must successfully complete a background check prior to volunteering. The background checks are conducted through Background Investigation Bureau (BIB). The background check is \$17.95 (base cost) and is paid for by the volunteer through a link on our website: Secure Volunteer. Once approved, the background check is good for 3yrs.
