Car Lines

As you have experienced the car lines by now there is more consistency and things are moving more smoothly. However, there is a need to be aware of a couple things.

School does not let out until 3:00pm and you may pick up at that time. Moving forward, students will not be called out of school earlier unless there is a medical appointment and proof will be necessary. Parents should be aware that normal classroom instruction is disruptive to the other students and teachers.
