The JIS Learning Center assistant teacher, under general supervision, provides assistance to a classroom teacher, performing a variety of tasks relating to the physical and instructional needs of students in a classroom setting; assists in the implementation of instructional programs, including self-help and behavior management as well as instruction. The assistant teacher performs related duties as required or assigned.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3. Provide support for individual students in and out of the classroom to enable them to fully participate in activities
- 4. Collaborate with other professionals, such as speech therapist, counselor, and motor therapist
- 5. Assist classroom teachers with maintaining student records
- 6. Support students with emotional or behavior concerns and assist them in developing appropriate social skills
- 7. Maintain communication with teacher regarding schedules, student progress and problem solving on a daily basis
- 8. Assist students with physical elements of hygiene, including but not limited to, bath rooming, occupational, feeding, clothing, etc.



- 9. Assist in implementing behavior management programs
- 10. Supervise and monitor students for appropriate behavior
- 11. Monitor students to ensure their safety and the safety of other persons
- 12. Foster and encourage the independence of students
- 13. Collect and maintain data as directed by supervising teacher
- 14. Assist in the planning, delivery, and assessment of instruction
- 15. Clarify assigned duties with classroom teachers in order to coordinate instructional efforts
- 16. Teach individuals and a small group on a wide range of subjects
- 17. Participate in teacher-parent conferences regarding students' progress of areas of growth
- 18. Support service learning and environmental stewardship initiatives
- 19. Attend staff meetings and serves on committees as required
- 20. Assist with whole school or grade level special events such as celebrations, assemblies & exhibitions when needed
- 21. Assist in the care and security of school equipment and materials
- 22. Notify facilities/administration of potential safety hazards
- 23. Prepare lesson materials, bulletin board displays, exhibits, equipment, and demonstration
- 24. Assist with newsletter, permission slips and other communication
- 25. Take class attendance, maintains attendance records
- 26. Collect and safeguard money from students for school-related projects

- 28. Plan, prepare and develop various teaching aids
