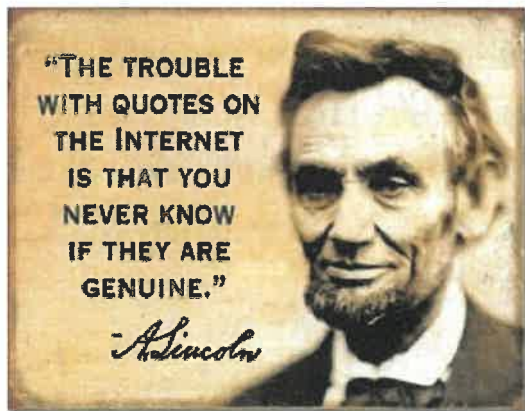


Spanish Club

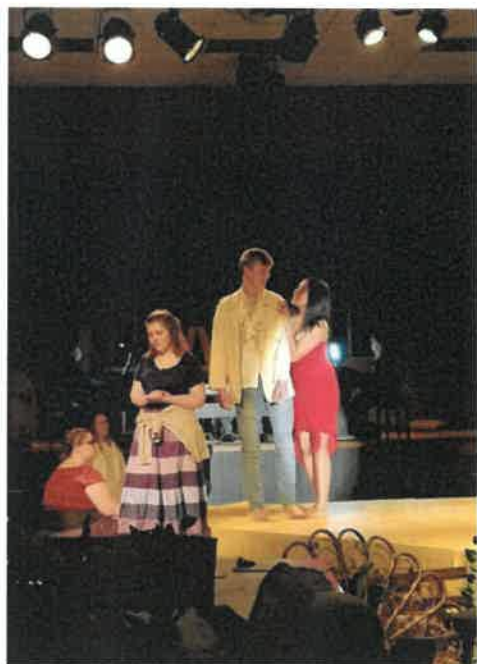
