KALEIDOSCOPE MASTER OF CEREMONIES - JOHN-PAUL FLAIM



John-Paul Flaim, better known as "JP" to listeners, is one of the hosts of "The Sports Junkies." The radio show can be heard each morning from 6:00 AM to 10:00 AM on 106.7 FM The Fan, simulcast on NBC Sports Washington, as well as 910 AM The Fan in Richmond.

JP grew up in Bowie, graduated from the University of Maryland at College Park, before receiving his J.D. from the Temple University Beasley School of Law. It was during his law school years that JP and three of his best childhood friends started a cable access television show on Bowie Community Television on a whim. "The Sports Junkies" cable access show spawned "The Sports Junkies" radio show, and the four friends have not looked back. The Junkies have dominated the airwaves for more than 26 years, taking over Howard Stern's morning radio slot in D.C. in 2006.

During his radio tenure, JP has done everything from opening his bar exam results on the air to fighting in a professional boxing match. Of the four Sports Junkies, he is known for playing devil's advocate, although he will argue that he often proffers the first opinion.

The married father of three has written two books, "Chasing Rocky" and "Still Barking." Perhaps most notably, JP coached a soccer team to a championship. The year was 1987, and his star player was 10-year-old Matthew Bickel, your DeMatha Catholic High School Director of Instrumental Music. JP currently resides in Gaithersburg, Maryland.

THE HISTORY OF THE DeMATHA MUSIC PROGRAM

DeMatha's Music Program began in 1970 with 19 students. The Music Program now enrolls approximately 30% of the student body.

The music curriculum includes four concert bands, three percussion ensembles, three string orchestras, two choruses, and six levels of music theory. The program includes the following extra-curricular groups: Philharmonic, two jazz ensembles, a pep band for basketball games, and numerous small ensembles.

The Music Program has received national and international acclaim. The National Catholic Bandmaster's Association named DeMatha's Wind Ensemble the top Catholic High School Band in the United States for 18 out of 20 years. Each year the Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Concert Band, the Advanced Percussion Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble II, DeMatha Sinfonia, Voices of DeMatha and DeMatha Harmonics perform at local, national and international music festivals. DeMatha performing groups consistently receive Superior ratings at these festivals and have received over 50 Gold Medals at music festivals held in Chicago, Toronto, Orlando, Atlanta, Gatlinburg, Nashville, Myrtle Beach, Virginia Beach and Daytona Beach.

Since 1970, several hundred student-musicians have been chosen to perform with the Maryland All-State Bands, Orchestras and Choruses. Over a thousand have performed with the Washington Archdiocesan Music Teacher Council Honor Bands and orchestras throughout the years.

Mr. James Turk, Dr. Michael Gatti, Mr. Matthew Bickel '95 and Mr. Carlos Castrillon '95 have a collective 107 years of teaching experience, including 77 years teaching at DeMatha.

THE DEMATHA INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC DEPARTMENT DIRECTORS

Mr. Matthew Bickel

Mr. Matthew Bickel, Director of Instrumental Music, Director of Orchestras and Associate Director of Bands, is a 1995 graduate of DeMatha Catholic High School. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Music Education and Music Performance from the Eastman School of Music. He received his Master's Degree in Trumpet Performance at the University of Maryland, College Park. As a trumpeter in the Prism Brass Quintet, Mr. Bickel has performed concerts all over the nation and has held residencies at the Boston University Tanglewood Institute, Chamber Music America's Rural Residency Program and the University of Maryland, College Park. Mr. Bickel won a position with the U.S. Air Force Ceremonial Brass in Washington DC, but continued on his path as a music educator. In addition to his work at DeMatha as an educator, Mr. Bickel has conducted the WAMTC Elementary Honors Band and the Prince George's County High School Honors Orchestra. Prior to teaching at DeMatha, Mr. Bickel taught both orchestra and band in the Prince George's County School System.

Mr. Carlos Castrillon, Director of Bands and Associate Director of Orchestras, is a 1995 graduate of DeMatha Catholic High School. Mr. Castrillon received a Bachelor's of Music Degree in French Horn Performance from the University of Maryland in 1999. Upon graduation, Mr. Castrillon moved to Cincinnati to pursue a graduate degree at the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music. During his time there, he was a musician with the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra and an extra musician with the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra. After moving back to Maryland, Mr. Castrillon became a band director in the Prince George's County Public School System and also served as a Co-Director for the Prince George's County Youth Orchestra. Mr. Castrillon has been a guest conductor for numerous honors ensembles in the state of Maryland. He is also the past President of the Washington Archdiocesan Music Teachers Council.



Dr. Michael Gatti

Dr. Michael Gatti, Music Department Chairman and Percussion Instructor, holds the degree Doctor of Musical Arts in Percussion Performance from the University of Maryland, College Park. Dr. Gatti directs three percussion ensembles, teaches private lessons, and instructs a course in the history of rock and roll music. He is also the adjunct professor of percussion at The Catholic University of America. Dr. Gatti is the Assistant Principal Percussionist of the Fairfax Symphony Orchestra. Additionally, he is employed as an extra musician in many of the Washington area's professional ensembles, including the National Gallery Orchestra, the Baltimore Chamber Orchestra, the Annapolis Symphony and the Washington Winds, the professional wind ensemble of Omega Studios, in Rockville, Maryland, dedicated to the recording of contemporary concert band literature.

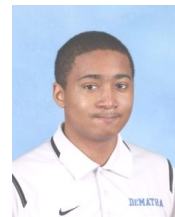
Mason Battle - Euphonium

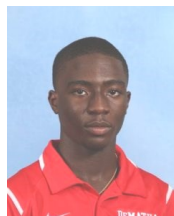
William Bradley - Trumpet
