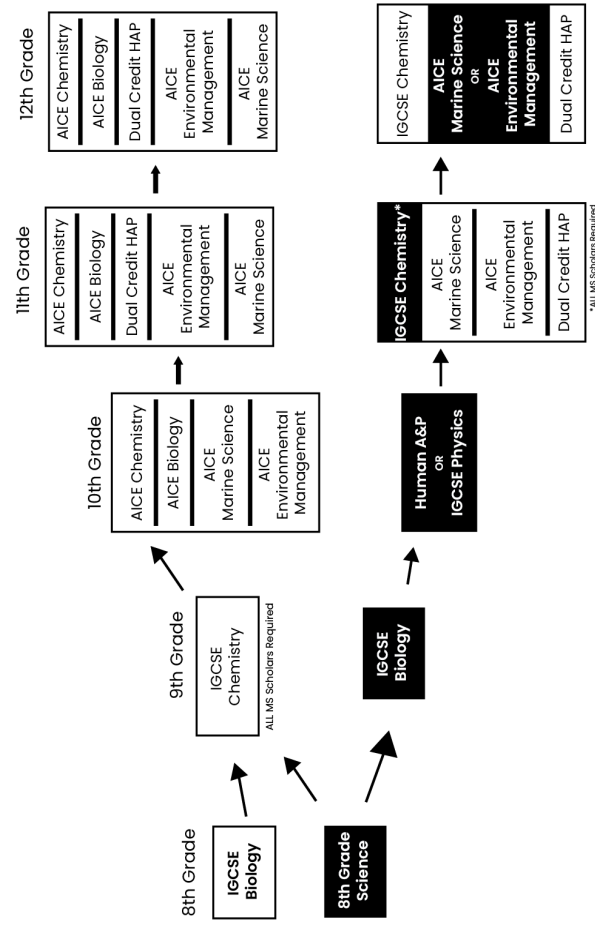
Mathematics Course Pathway



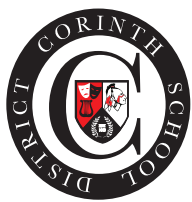
History Course Pathway

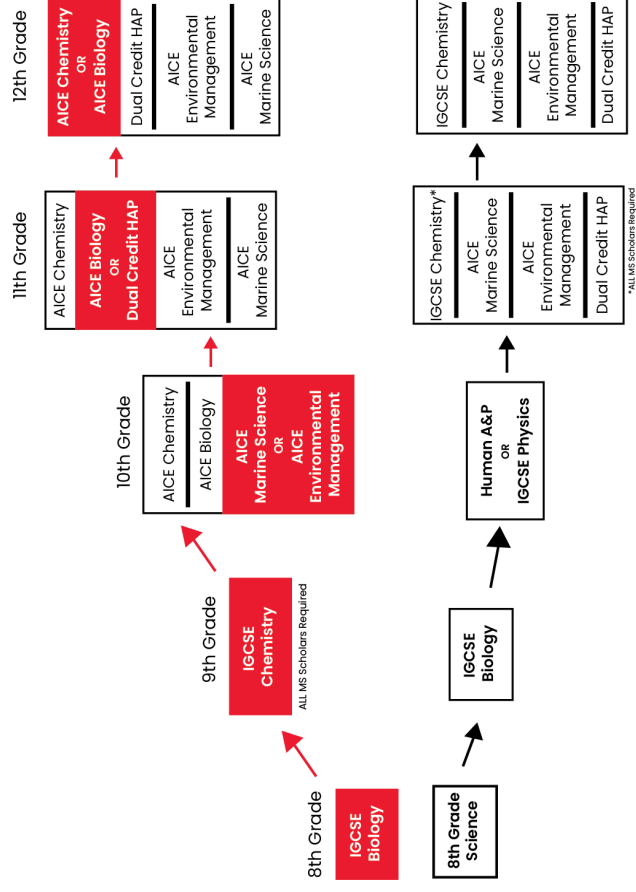
Mathematics Course Pathway

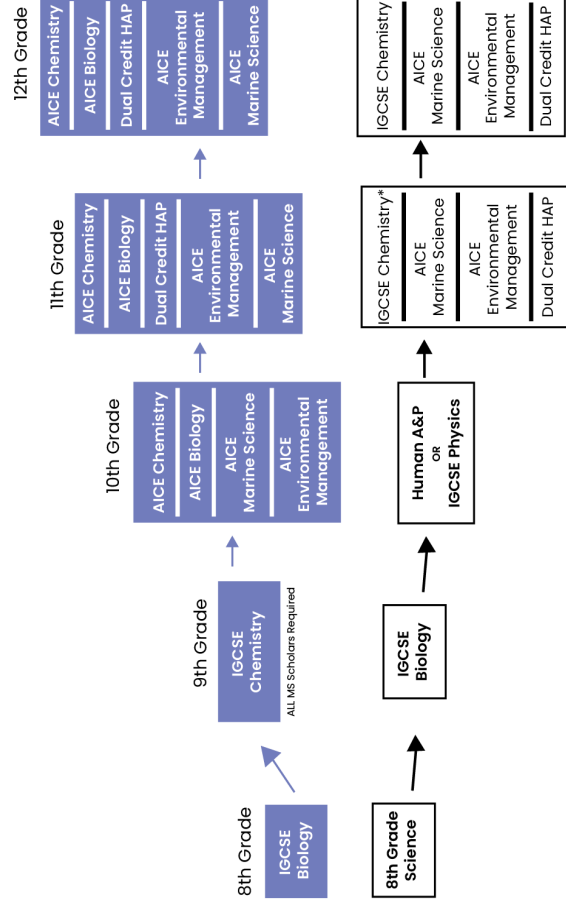
Mathematics Course Pathway

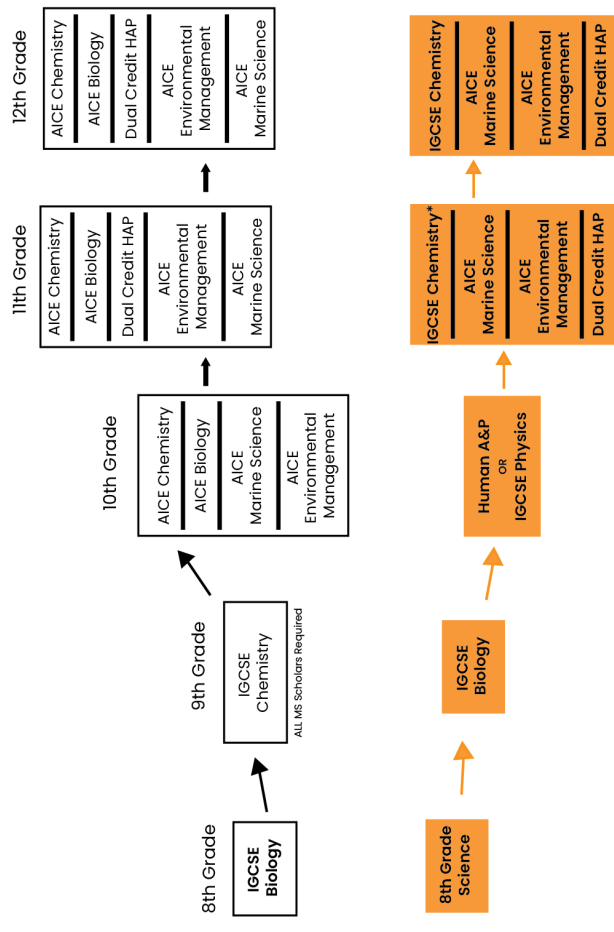
Mathematics Course Pathway

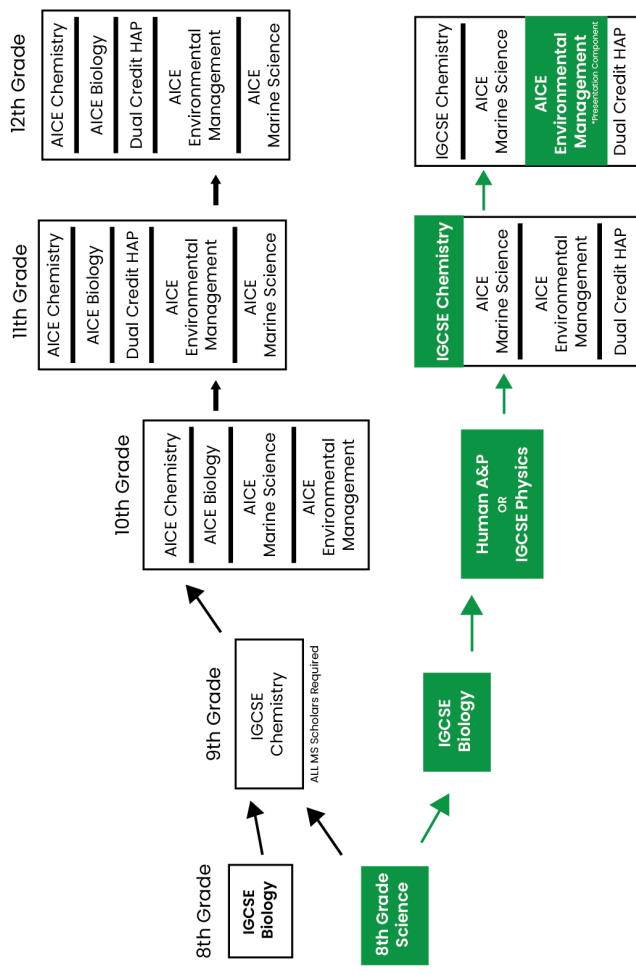
Mathematics Course Pathway

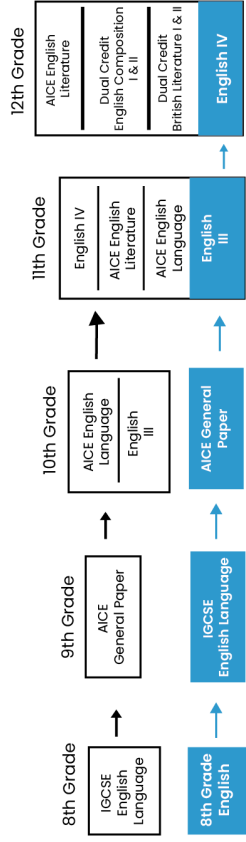
- Earn 24 credits (12 must be regular education Carnegie units)

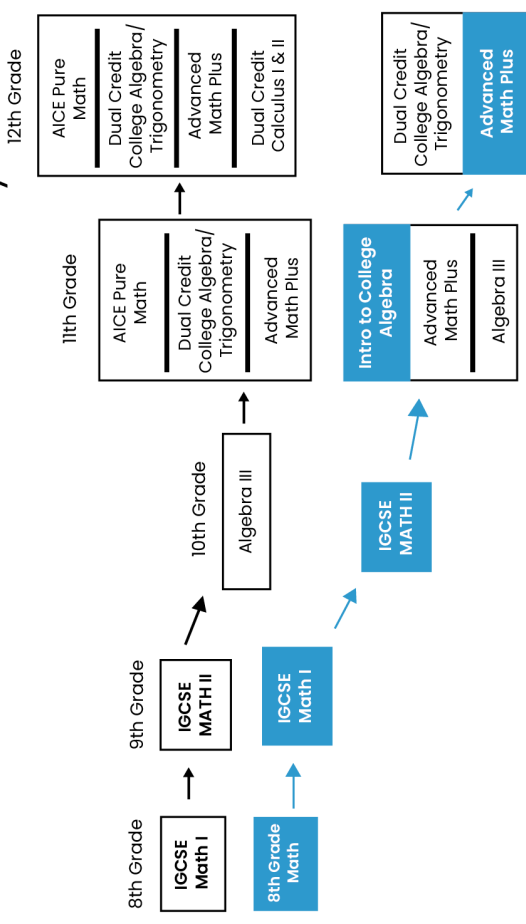

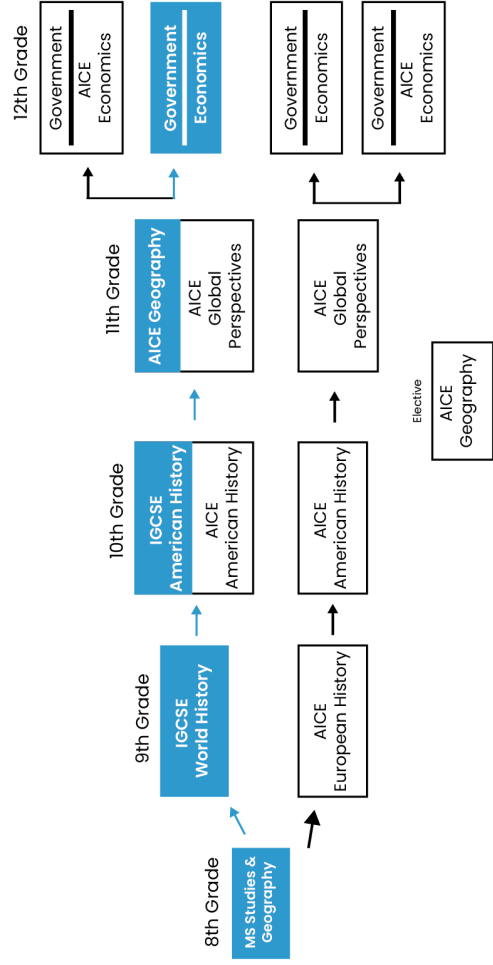
English Course Pathway
