

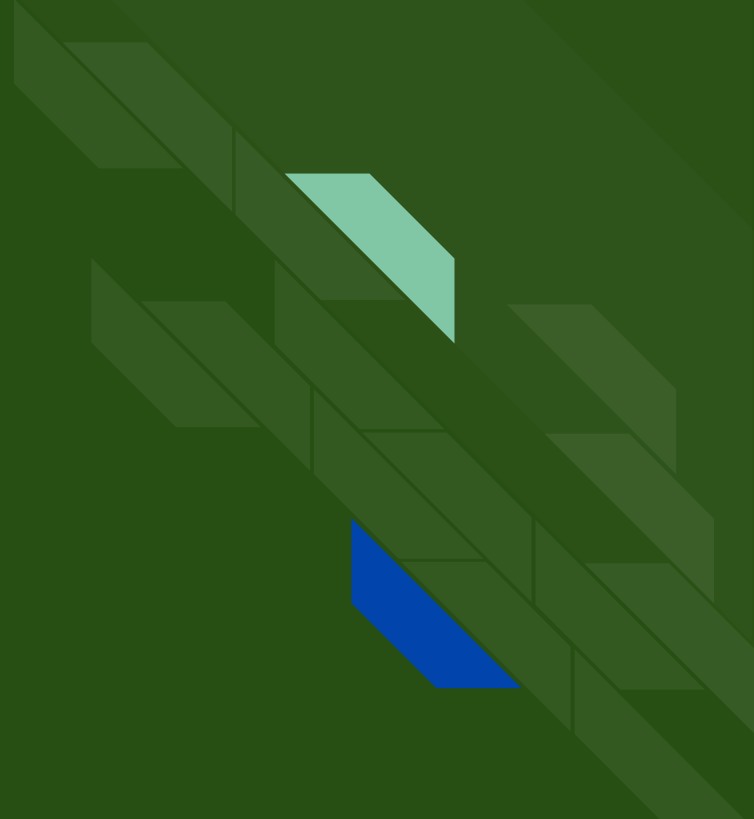

- High quality curriculum and assessments in all grades
- High quality professional development for all teachers
- Building school-based expertise through leadership roles (Content Leaders and Mentor Teachers)
- A Professional Development Plan to ensure teachers are preparing for units and building content knowledge.



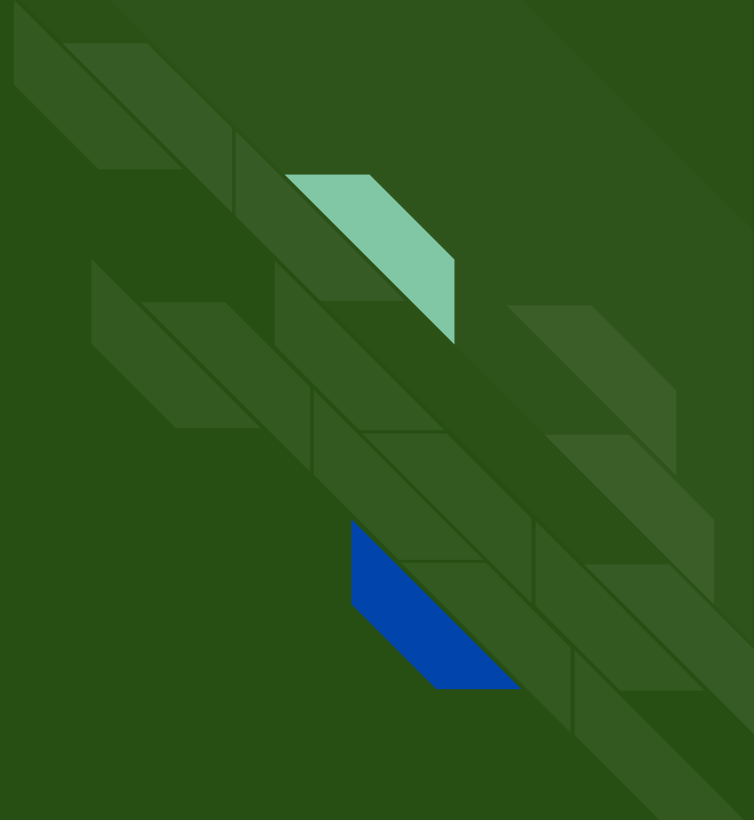

# 2022-2023 School Improvement Goals and Priorities

Given the data we've shared, Ponchatoula High School is focused on the following priorities for the 2022-2023 school year:

By Spring of 2023, PHS will increase the percent of students scoring Mastery and Above on the LEAP 2025 Assessment from: DRAFT GOALS

English I	39% to 43%
English II	48% to 52%
Algebra I	24% to 28%
Geometry	28% to 32%
American History	17% to 21%
Biology	26% to 30%



# 2022-2023 School Improvement Goals and Priorities Continued

Given the data we've shared, Ponchatoula High School is focused on the following priorities for the 2022-2023 school year:

- By the Spring of 2023, PHS will increase the percent of **students of color** scoring Mastery and above from 24% to 32% on the LEAP 2025 Assessment.
- By the Spring of 2023, PHS will increase the percent of **students with disabilities** scoring Mastery and above from 15% to 20% on the LEAP 2025 Assessment.
- By the Spring of 2023, PHS will increase the percent of students **meeting their growth targets** from 41% to 45% on the LEAP 2025 Assessment.
- From Spring 2022 to Spring 2023, the PHS SPS will increase from \_\_\_\_\_ as evidenced by LEAP scores and SPS calculations through the implementation of Tier 1 and TPSS approved curriculum in all subject areas at all grade levels (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) to support student mastery.

Here is our timeline for attaining the goals outlined in our school's improvement plan.

<b>Timeframe</b>	<b>Activity</b>
Spring-Summer 2022	Determine Effectivies of 2021-2022 SWP, Write CNA and SWP for 2022-2023
Fall 2022	Finalize our PHS goals, hold consistent PLCs with teachers, hold consistent ILTs with teachers, and analyze data weekly
Winter 2023	Assess our plan with our stakeholder team, hold consistent with PLCs and ILTs. Progress monitor for student academic growth.
