

The Dare County Board of Education met in **special session** on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, at First Flight High School. Members in attendance were Board Chairman David Twiddy, Vice-Chair Susan Bothwell, Mary Ellon Ballance, Frank Hester, Margaret Lawler, Joe Tauber, and Carl Woody. Board Attorney Rachel Hitch was also in attendance.

Chairman Twiddy called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting. He then requested a motion to approve the agenda. Susan Bothwell moved that the Board approve the agenda as requested. The motion was seconded by Carl Woody and approved 7 to 0 by the Board.

Next, Margaret Lawler made a motion that the Board go into closed session to consult with the Board of Education attorney to preserve the attorney-client privilege as provided in N.C.G.S.143-318.11(a)(3); and to consider confidential personnel matters as provided in N.C.G.S.143-318.11(a)(6). The motion was seconded by Frank Hester and approved 7 to 0 by the Board.

The Board went into closed session at 4:03 p.m. and returned to open session at 4:53 p.m. No action was taken following closed session, and with there being no further business, Mary Ellon Ballance made a motion to adjourn the meeting.
