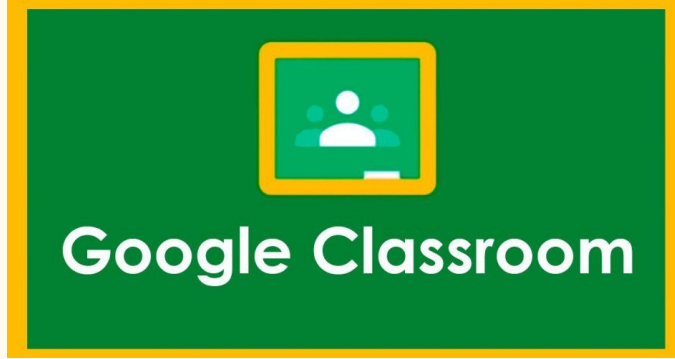

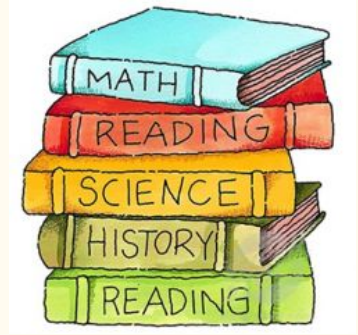

Christopher High School Graduation Requirements

- **Credits:**
 - 220 credits total in **the required** subjects
- **Community Service Hours:**
 - **Seniors: Must complete 55 hours before May 1st**
 - **Juniors: 40 hours by the end of Junior Year (total of 60 by the time you graduate!)**



Am I on track to graduate?

Juniors- You should have 120 credits completed by now. Less than 100 credits is deficient.



Seniors- You should have 180 credits completed now. Less than 160 is deficient and *YOU NEED A PLAN!!*

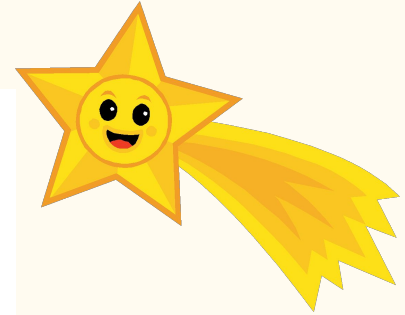

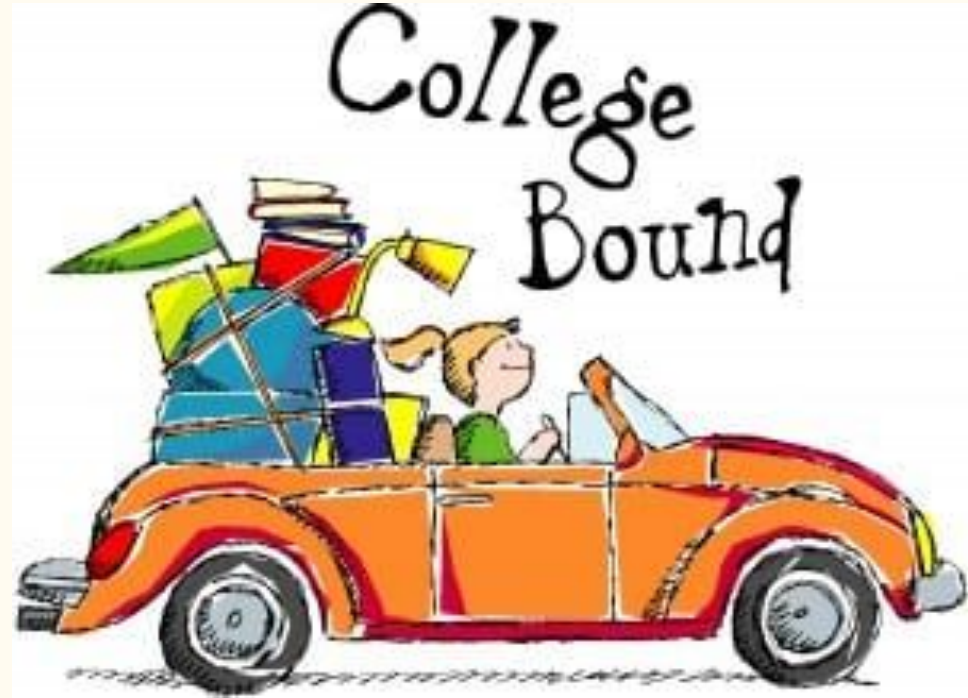


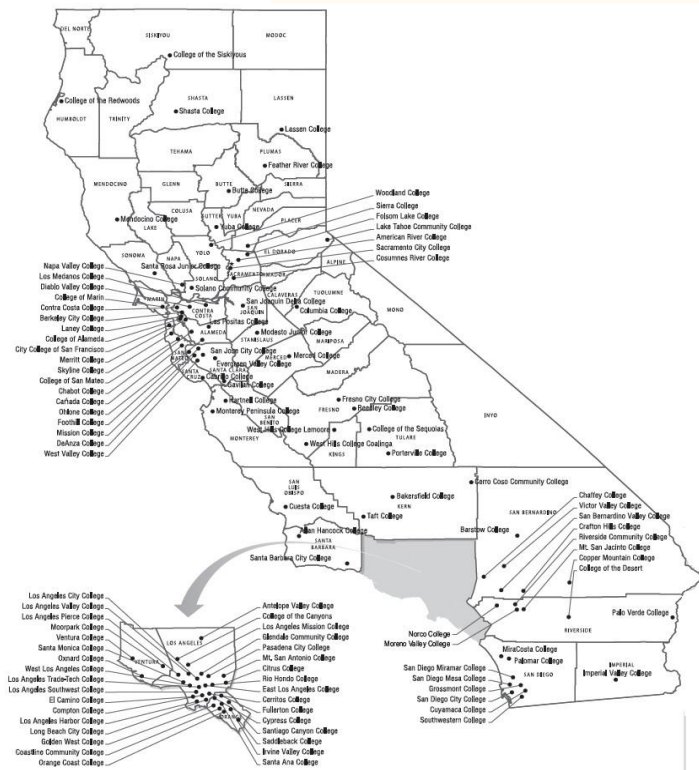

- ❑ **Schools - San Jose State University, Sacramento State University, CSU East Bay, etc.**
- ❑ **A-G Requirements - minimum GPA - minimum 2.5 +**
- ❑ **Deadlines for required documents vary**

NO SAT/ACT tests will be required for your graduating class

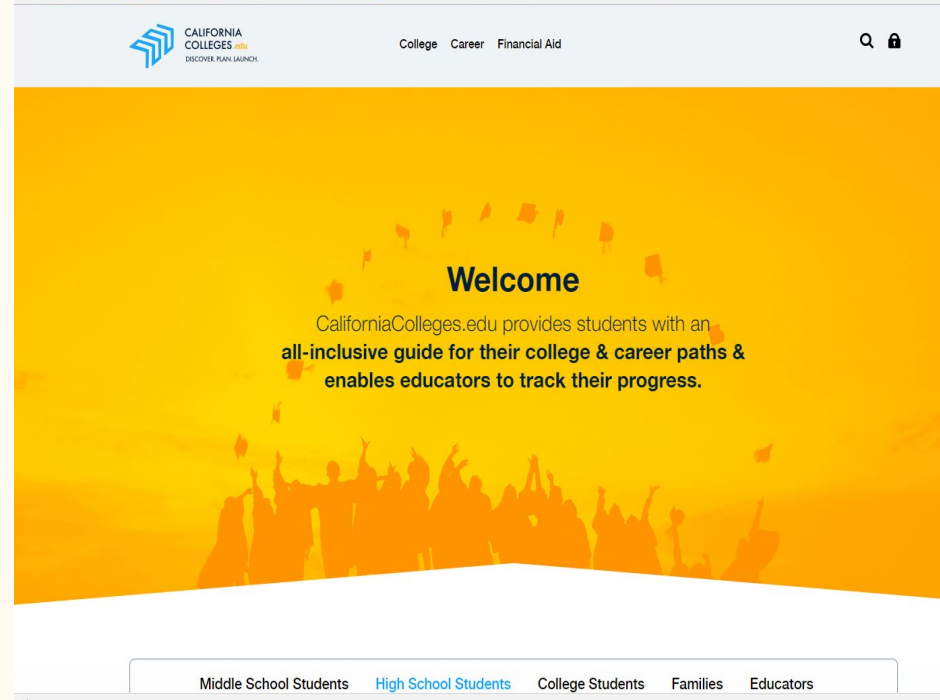

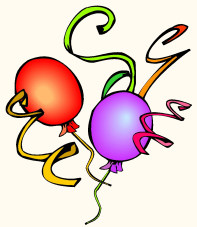
