# Christopher High School Graduation Requirements

To graduate from Christopher High School students must:

- 1. Complete 220 semester credits in the specific subject requirements. (Each semester class is worth 5 credits and students are enrolled in 30 credits of coursework each semester).
- 2. Pass 3 years of math (up through Math III)
- 3. Complete 80 Community Service Hours

World Language	20 credits
Career Tech Education	05 credits
Electives	35 credits
Total	220 credits

## Things you need to know....


- ☐ It is important to pass ALL your classes! You will have to repeat the courses that you do not pass!
- □ P.E.- The requirement is 4 years- unless you pass the fitness test!
- ☐ If you get C's or higher in all your courses- you will be eligible for a 4-year university as a senior! Strive for A's and B's!




## What is "Community Service"?

- 3. Always make a copy for your records.
- 4. Turn in the original to Ms. Sylvia in the ASB office.
- 5. Turn in the form within 30 days of doing the service!!
