BACKGROUND

A. On June 30, 2020 Governor Whitmer issued her Executive Order 2020-142 and shared Michigan's Return to School Roadmap. The Roadmap is aligned with Michigan's Safe Start Plan, using the "six phase approach" as a basis for reopening schools. The Roadmap provides requirements, recommendations and guidance unique for each phase under which schools may operate. As such, Governor Whitmer requires each district in Michigan to submit a Board approved "Preparedness and Response Plan" to the local ISD on August 17, 2020, and then to the Michigan Department of Education to be approved on August 19, 2020 to allow school to resume.

B. For Phases 1-3, the 4:1 model, the 2:3 model and the 100% Remote Learning model; all Marshall Public Schools seated courses are offered in a virtual format for the 2020-2021 school year.
