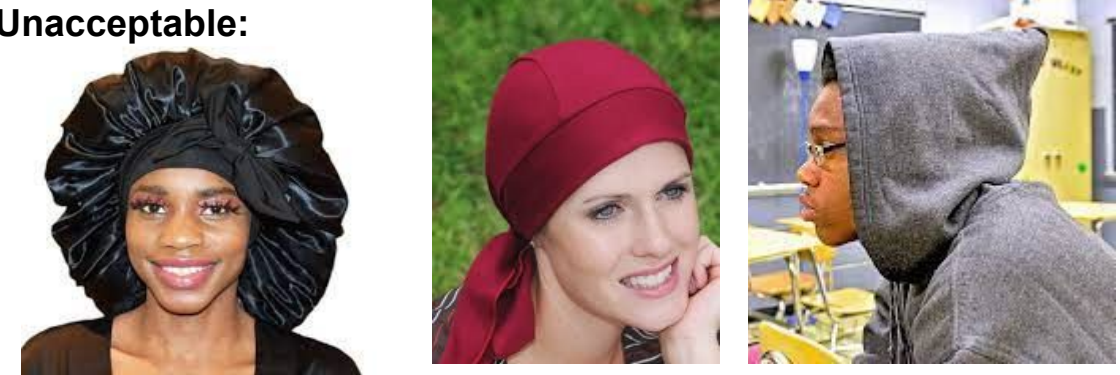
Head:

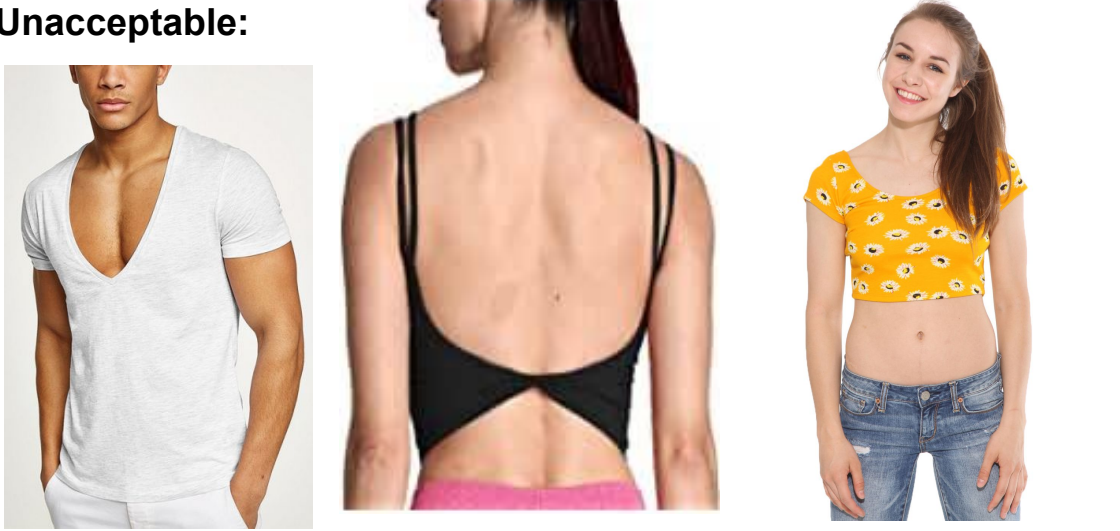
Upper Garments

- must be worn so that the torso, which includes the chest, midriff, and back, are covered.
- Oversized garments or extremely brief garments showing midriffs or backs, or containing plunging necklines are prohibited.
- must have straps that cover the shoulders.
- See through garments of any type are not permitted.

Lower Garments

- Shorts, skirts, dresses, pants and similar outer garments must have an appropriate and modest length and fit.
- the waistline of such apparel must be worn at the student's waistline.

Applies to all Clothing

- Sufficient to conceal all undergarments
- Slogans or advertising on clothing, jewelry, buttons, and/or accessories which by their controversial, discriminatory, profane, and/or obscene nature that disrupts the educational setting are prohibited.
- Any clothing, jewelry, buttons, and/or accessories that promote illegal or violent conduct, or affiliation with groups that promote illegal or violent conduct such as, but not limited to, the unlawful use of weapons, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or drug paraphernalia, or clothing that contains threats are prohibited.
- Spiked, sharp or sharpened clothing, chains and/or accessories are prohibited (due to safety concerns)
