The virtual meeting commenced at 12:00 p.m. Mr. Jeffery Reid, Co-Chair of the committee, introduced himself and welcomed the committee to the meeting. He explained that the purpose of the committee is to discuss any District safety/security issues. Items were discussed on the basis of their location.

A School Safety/Security meeting was held on Tuesday, May 25, 2022. Several concerns were presented to the teachers at various schools, mostly in the categories of keys and locks, security cameras, card readers and PA systems in the portable trailers. As of Thursday, June 2, 2022 all known issues with keys and locks have been resolved. Mr. Forman and Mr. Hardy are looking to transition key and lock issues away from internal staff to an outside vendor. The PA system in the portable trailer at Park has been completed, and non-working security cameras will be repaired by June 6th. Dr. DeNicola is visiting various schools, and reviewing and resolving issues with card readers and phone systems, and expects most issues to be resolved by June 3, 2022, with any outstanding issues resolved by June 10, 2022.
