Theology 4: Social Justice and Adult Spirituality
Grade 12

Pope Francis writes, “The world tells us to seek success, power, and money; God tells us to seek humility, service and love.” In Theology 4, students will explore how their faith is applied to their lives as they seek to become responsible members of a global society. Students are introduced to Catholic Social Teaching and its relationship to social issues in our world, they will examine the role of ethics in health care, and they will conclude by learning what it means to discern God’s call or vocation in their lives. Students will develop skills in critical thinking, reading, writing, research, and public speaking. Upon completion of this course, students will have discovered what it means to be a person of faith and how they might live their faith in a modern and diverse global society.
