

Academics

- WASC accredited; IBO authorized
- High School Diploma requires a minimum of 24 credits; most students earn above minimum requirements
- IB Diploma Programme since 2010
- SIS offers 31 IB DP course options; students may take a maximum of 6
- Inclusive admissions policy into IB Diploma Programme
- Students in Grades 9 and 10 complete a standards-based curriculum graded on 1-7 scale


APPLICATION PROCESSES AT SIS

SIS limits students to 10 applications worldwide. Official transcripts and letters of recommendation are sent directly to admissions offices, or through CIALFO using Parchment services. Unofficial transcripts are neither signed nor stamped; these are provided for students to selfreport. SIS is a registered SAT test center for SIS students only; we do not prepare students for SAT, nor do we report SAT data.

STATEMENT OF PANDEMIC IMPACT ON CLASS OF 2023


The Class of 2023 was online from February through April 2020; thereafter our school has usually been open for in-person learning for those present in China. The 2020-21 school year commenced in August with 90% of students and 40% of staff on campus using a blended model with substitute teachers supervising many lessons in person. The 2021-2022 school year resumed with all staff on campus. Beginning February 27, 2022, online learning resumed due to increasing Covid cases within the Shenzhen area. SIS resumed in-person learning on April 11, 2022, and internal exams were still held in May 2022. The 2022-2023 school year resumed with in-person learning, however, due to increasing Covid cases within the Shenzhen area, we began online learning on August 30, 2022. We resumed in-person learning on September 15, 2022.


