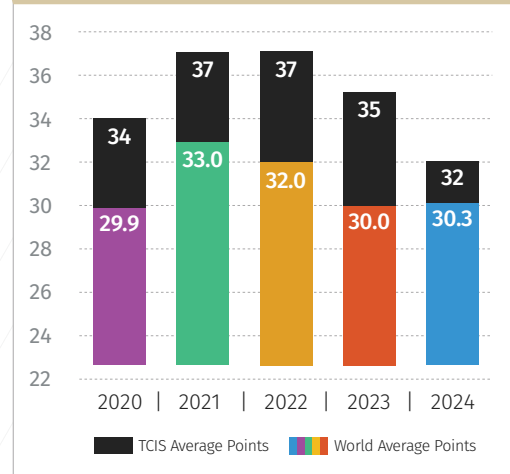
As a Three-Programme IB World School, DP courses represent the highest level classes offered at TCIS for grades 11-12.
