Lunch D-hall: (open every day during lunches)

- 1. Students will report to lunch d-hall before getting in line for lunch
- 2. Students must report to detention on their assigned date. If a student arrives late, he or she will not be admitted and will be assigned an additional lunch detention to serve at another date.
- 3. During detention, no student is allowed to use a cell phone or other electronic device (i.e., iPod).
- 4. Students may not leave detention for restroom breaks, etc. (please plan accordingly)
- 5. Students must sign in and out of detention.
- 6. Students may bring homework to complete.
- 7. No talking during lunch detention. You may communicate with the detention supervisor by raising your hand for permission to speak.
- 8. No sleeping during lunch detention.

ASD, or Saturday School

- 1. Students must report by the assigned area no later than 5 minutes before the above times.
- 2. If a student arrives late, he or she will not be admitted and will be assigned an additional consequence to serve at another date.
- During ASD, and Saturday School, no student is allowed to be in possession of a cell phone or other electronic device (i.e., iPod). All electronics will be collected on the teacher's desk when students report for detention.
- 4. Students may not leave ASD and Saturday School for restroom breaks, etc. (please plan accordingly). The teacher will take the group for scheduled restroom breaks during Saturday School.
- 5. Students must sign in and out to prove attendance. Students that leave early will not get credit for serving the consequence.
- 6. Students will only receive a Tutorial Bus Pass if they stay for the whole duration of ASD.
- 7. If a student is removed for being disruptive or refusing to work, they will receive the next higher consequence ASD→ 1ISS→2ISS→OSS
- 8. Parents will be notified by an administrator when these consequences are assigned and a written notice is sent home with the student.
- 9. During detention, students may work on homework as well as complete Attendance Make-up Hours. Students must work the entire assigned time.
- 10. No talking during detention. You may communicate with the detention supervisor by raising your hand for permission to speak.
- 11. No sleeping during detention.
