Our School

TASIS England is an American International school that was founded by Mrs. Mary Crist Fleming in 1976 for students ages 3-18. We are a private, independent, co-educational, boarding and day school with students from over 70 countries.

Our Curriculum

TASIS England offers a demanding academic program within the Upper School that prepares students for further studies at universities worldwide. In Grades 9 and 10 students follow the American High School Diploma, and in Grades 11 and 12 students work towards either the IB Diploma Programme or continue the American Diploma with Advanced Placement (AP) courses. TASIS England also offers Honors Linear Algebra, a mathematics course containing advanced college-level linear algebra and multivariable calculus as well as Honors Quantum Computer Science for students looking to continue the study of programming beyond AP Computer Science A. In order to graduate from TASIS England, students must fulfill the following high school equivalency requirements towards a graduation certification, including 60 hours of service:

- 4 credits of English
- 3 credits of Mathematics (Algebra II is a required course)
- 3 credits of History
- 1 credit of Humanities
- 3 credits of Science
- 2 credits of Additional Language, with a third level proficiency in 1 Language
- 1 credit of Arts (Drama, Music, Art, or Computer Graphic Design)
- Physical Education in Grades 9 and 10

Predicted grades are collated for AP and IB courses.

Class of 2023 IB Diploma Snapshot

- 45 IB candidates, 38 Full IB Diploma candidates, took 244 exams
- 27% Bilingual Diplomas
- 26% achieved over 38 IB Diploma points
- The top individual score was 43
- The average point score was 34 (world average 30)
- 97% IB Diploma pass rate (world average 79%)

2023 Advanced Placement Snapshot

- 173 students took 427 AP exams, with an average score of 4.0
- 88% pass rate (world average 64%)
- 88 students qualified as AP Scholars with an average score of 4.16
 - 36 AP Scholars
 - 14 AP Scholars with Honors
 - 38 AP Scholars with Distinction
- 24 AP courses were offered
- Approval required by Academic Dean to take more than 3 AP courses
- On average the graduating class of 2023 completed 4 AP exams while at TASIS England

In addition to our IB and AP programs, we support the language acquisition of English Language Learners through our English-as-an-Additional Language Program and our International Section that provides specialized instruction in English, History, and the Sciences. Within a transcript, courses with these services are specified with "International" or "EAL" after the subject name.

Response to the pandemic

2020-21 School Year: TASIS offered hybrid or in-person learning, with the majority of students opting for in-person instruction. Between January 6 - March 8, 2021, all students participated in online learning during the second UK government lockdown. Upon our return to on-campus learning, co-curricular activities and sports resumed. The Community Service Program requirement was suspended for this school year.

2021-22 School Year: The majority of students returned for in-person learning, with a very small number of students utilizing our Hybrid Learning Program. Co-curricular activities and sports continued, including the return of competitive sports fixtures.

Co-curricular and Sports Program

TASIS England believes in combining curricular with co-curricular education to create a well-rounded student. All TASIS England students complete our Community Service Program or the IB Creativity, Activity, and Service requirement. This extends the school day until 6:30 p.m.

TASIS England is a founding member of the International Schools Athletic Association (ISAA) and has over 30 competitive sports teams, from Lacrosse to Basketball, that travel to ISAA European Competitions. TASIS England also offers competitive golf and badminton as well as recreational sports such as fitness, yoga, and horseback riding.

There are currently 27 co-curricular clubs and student-led activities, ranging from special interest and service-based groups to the Duke of Edinburgh Award and the TASIS Student Leadership Academy. We encourage an exploration of the Arts which form a large part of our co-curricular experience with concerts performed by our orchestra, choirs, ensembles, various bands, and an a cappella group, art exhibitions created by our Visual Arts students, and theatre productions performed by our Drama groups. Our active Student Prefect and Student Leadership teams are responsible for coordinating an extensive and varied program of on-campus events. Learning is further enhanced through a multitude of educational trips throughout the London area and an extensive European travel program.

College and University Acceptances

Approximately 91% of the TASIS England Class of 2023 pursued higher education within one year of graduation in the UK (36%), USA (30%), and other countries. The remaining alumni study, volunteer, work, or intern during their gap year, often submitting applications during this time. Over 80 scholarships were awarded totalling over £3.8 million.
