



## PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION

As this position is new, the coordinator will work with the team to create an MTSS manual that delineates the interventions strategies that the district will use as part of the model.

## TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE

Successful teaching experience totaling at least five years as well as knowledge of the MTSS framework is preferred. Any combination of training, experience, and/or coursework in the area of behavior preferred. A background in school psychology is highly preferred. Experience planning and presenting to larger groups recommended.

## PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

The employee is occasionally required to sit and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 10 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

## QUALIFICATIONS

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** Demonstrated knowledge and awareness of the unique needs and behavior of students. Sufficient/successful previous working experience with primary responsibilities listed above. Ability to identify the emotional needs of students, implement appropriate counseling services, work independently and as a team member, maintain accurate records, establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, staff and community resources, adherence to established timelines, demonstrate effective oral and written communication skills. Characteristics necessary to establish a desirable role model for pupils. Establishes and maintains acceptable standards for physical and mental health.

**Physical Abilities:** Vision sufficient to read printed materials; hearing and speech sufficient to conduct normal in-person and telephone conversations; mobility sufficient to efficiently perform the duties of the position. Should be able to lift 50 pounds. (Consideration may be given to reasonable accommodation for above.)

**Education, Licenses or Certificates:** Pupil Personnel Services Credential (or equivalent), Master's Degree from an accredited university or college. Drivers License and Vehicle required for travel to various locations.
