RESOLUTION 13-040 VOUCHER PROGRAMS

“Whereas, such vouchers would be granted without regard to the academic performance or quality of the public school that the student is assigned to attend; and

Whereas, the second voucher expansion proposed by the Governor offers EdChoice vouchers to students enrolled in schools that fail to meet the Third Grade Reading Guarantee for two successive years; and

Whereas, the operation of the proposed programs would effectively reduce funds from the already financially beleaguered local public school districts, resulting in fewer resources for the education of remaining students; and

Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the Troy City School District, does hereby express its opposition to these provisions in HB 59; and

Be it further resolved that the Board of Education of the Troy City School District expresses its opposition to any legislation that seeks to transfer public dollars to support private education; and

Therefore, be it resolved that the Treasurer be directed to spread this resolution upon the minutes of the Board of Education and that copies of the resolution be forwarded to the Governor and members of the Ohio General Assembly.”
