St. Michael Catholic High School in Fairhope, Alabama is seeking a principal for the 2023-24 school year. This Roman Catholic, co-educational, college-preparatory high school was founded in 2016 by the Archdiocese of Mobile under the leadership of Most Reverend Thomas J. Rodi. The school is located on 80 acres in lower Baldwin County, Alabama, in the beautiful and growing community of Fairhope, on the Eastern Shore of Mobile Bay. Current enrollment is 354 students in 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grades. It is accredited by Cognia.

The Catholic faith is central to the school community. In addition to a four-year theology curriculum, students and staff pray often as a school - at weekly Mass and other sacramental celebrations, before school starts each day, at school assemblies, and before all sporting events. Students of all faiths and denominations are welcome.

St. Michael Catholic High School aspires for its students to become scholars, leaders and disciples of Jesus Christ. The student population is diverse in its talents and abilities. The school aims to immerse students in a culture of optimism and high academic standards so they develop habit of mind, critical thinking skills and the self-discipline needed for success in college and beyond.

The academic program seeks to provide coursework which challenges students from a broad range of talents and areas of strength. As a college preparatory school, all levels are designed to prepare students for college. In 2022, 50 students were designated as "A.P. Scholars" by the College Board on the basis of their A.P. exam results. Of these, 18 were awarded "AP Scholars with Distinction," the highest honor possible. 5 received "AP Scholars with Honor" recognition, and 27 were named "AP Scholars."

Students are offered a wide variety of extracurricular activities to support their social emotional development, as well as their spiritual and intellectual growth. Currently approximately 80% of our students are members of at least one extracurricular organization/athletic team. From growing band, choir, and art programs to active clubs such as the Environmental Club, Health & Wellness, Pro- Life, Mother Teresa Service, Peer Helpers, Girls Bible Study, Spanish, Scholars Bowl, Student Ambassadors and more, our students immerse themselves in and out of the classroom.

The athletic program currently offers 20 varsity sports including football, volleyball, cheerleading, cross country, basketball, baseball, soccer, swimming, bowling, golf, softball, track, and tennis. Junior varsity teams include volleyball, basketball, and soccer. The school also sponsors middle school programs in football and volleyball for their three elementary partner schools.
