

TEACH TO EQUIP

Teach to Equip is MCA's strategic and intentional plan to equip students with a Biblical Worldview through the curriculum utilized, instructional methodology implemented, and professional development training provided to instructional staff. **Teach to Equip** includes professional development, which is designed to foster and promote growth, improvement, learning in the areas of curriculum, instructional methods, assessments, social and emotional learning, and Biblical integration. The first semester of the 2022-2023 school year, MCA's instructional staff members are participating in monthly professional developing sessions utilizing the content in Dr. Alan Pue's book, *Rethinking Discipleship: Why Christian Schooling Matters*. The sessions include components on discipling students for the development of a biblical worldview, foundational components of a life lived for Christ, and the biblical precept of Imago Dei of all people being image bearers of Christ. **Teach to Equip** includes an intentional review, through collaboration and careful consideration, of all text resources and supplemental materials to ensure developmentally appropriate tools have been selected through which a Biblical worldview can be analyzed and synthesized for the cognitive and spiritual growth and development of the student. Finally, **Teach to Equip** supports instructional methodology and pedagogy through a series of observation and instructional coaching sessions where teachers are commended and encourage through contemporary instructional best practices.
