All students will be involved with Digital Citizenship lessons this week.

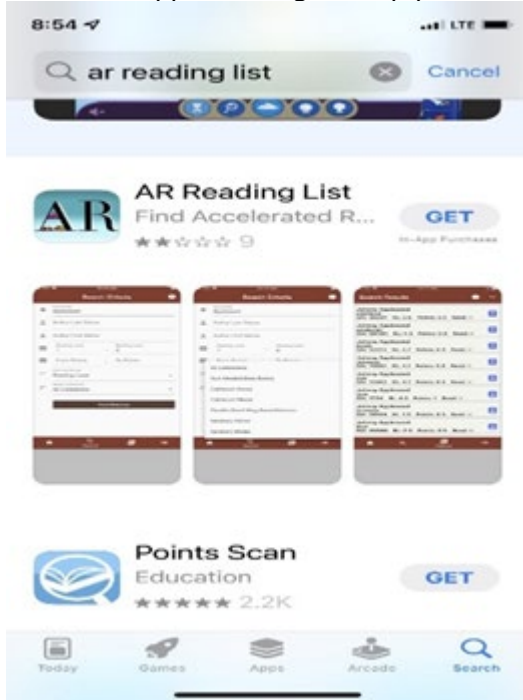
