Unaccompanied (no adult) homeless youth enrollment:

MUST enroll even if all enrollment papers are not available & identify in omega (for calpad reporting purposes)

- Call authorities (CPS or police) only if student is in danger to self or cannot care for self
- Locate documents through prior school if possible
- Assistance in locating past records contact Olga Valdez, Foster Youth Specialist at (909)252-4504
- Contact San Bernardino contacts for birth certificate and ID waivers if needed
- Contact Alicia to use Title I funding if appropriate for clothing, school supplies, food
- Help student with transportation to/from school site as needed for facilitation, testing, tutoring, etc.
- Determine if AB216 applies for high school graduation (policy can be obtained from Sped department)
- Assist student with applying for Calfresh (food assistance) if applicable (website will assist with eligibility information)
